## The Forms of Dog

Infinitive	<b>to dog</b>
Present Tense	<b>dog / dogs</b>
Past Tense	<b>dogged</b>
Present Participle	<b>dogging</b>
Past Participle	<b>dogged</b>

## Conjugate Dog

### Dog in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>dog</b>	We <b>dog</b>
You <b>dog</b>	You <b>dog</b>
He/She/It <b>dogs</b>	They <b>dog</b>

## **Dog in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>am dogging</b>	We <b>are dogging</b>
You <b>are dogging</b>	You <b>are dogging</b>
He/She/It <b>is dogging</b>	They <b>are dogging</b>

## **Dog in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>have dogged</b>	We <b>have dogged</b>
You <b>have dogged</b>	You <b>have dogged</b>
He/She/It <b>has dogged</b>	They <b>have dogged</b>

## **Dog in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>have been dogging</b>	We <b>have been dogging</b>
You <b>have been dogging</b>	You <b>have been dogging</b>
He/She/It <b>has been dogging</b>	They <b>have been dogging</b>

## **Dog in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>dogged</b>	We <b>dogged</b>
You <b>dogged</b>	You <b>dogged</b>
He/She/It <b>dogged</b>	They <b>dogged</b>

## **Dog in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I was **dogging**                      We were **dogging**  
You were **dogging**                You were **dogging**  
He/She/It was **dogging**        They were **dogging**

**Dog in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had **dogged**                      We had **dogged**  
You had **dogged**                You had **dogged**  
He/She/It had **dogged**        They had **dogged**

**Dog in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had been **dogging**                We had been **dogging**  
You had been **dogging**            You had been **dogging**  
He/She/It had been **dogging**    They had been **dogging**

**Dog in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will **dog**                      We will **dog**  
You will **dog**                You will **dog**  
He/She/It will **dog**        They will **dog**

**Dog in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will be **dogging**                We will be **dogging**  
You will be **dogging**            You will be **dogging**  
He/She/It will be **dogging**    They will be **dogging**

**Dog in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have dogged**

**We will have dogged**

**You will have dogged**

**You will have dogged**

**He/She/It will have dogged**

**They will have dogged**

**Dog in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been dogging**

**We will have been dogging**

**You will have been dogging**

**You will have been dogging**

**He/She/It will have been dogging**

**They will have been dogging**
