arrogance The quality of being arrogant.

authoritarianism Lack of concern for the wishes or opinions of others.

Obstinate or unreasonable attachment to a belief, opinion, or faction; in

particular, prejudice against a person or people on the basis of their

membership of a particular group.

The difficulties of combating prejudice and **bigotry**.

dictatorialness The manner in which something is expressed in words- G.S.Patton.

doctrinairism A stubborn person of arbitrary or arrogant opinions.

high-handedness Overbearing pride evidenced by a superior manner toward inferiors.



imperativeness The state of demanding notice or attention.imperiousness The trait of being imperious and overbearing.
