- *The tendency to lay down principles as undeniably true, without consideration of evidence or the opinions of others.*
- *The intolerance and prejudice of a bigot.*



Synonyms of "Dogmatism" as a noun (9 Words)

- arrogance** The quality of being arrogant.
*The **arrogance** of this man is astounding.*
- assertiveness** Confident and forceful behaviour.
*She has difficulty standing up for herself even when **assertiveness** may be warranted.*
- authoritarianism** Lack of concern for the wishes or opinions of others.
- bigotry** Obstinate or unreasonable attachment to a belief, opinion, or faction; in particular, prejudice against a person or people on the basis of their membership of a particular group.
*The difficulties of combating prejudice and **bigotry**.*
- dictatorialness** The manner in which something is expressed in words- G.S.Patton.
- doctrinairism** A stubborn person of arbitrary or arrogant opinions.
- high-handedness** Overbearing pride evidenced by a superior manner toward inferiors.

imperativeness The state of demanding notice or attention.

imperiousness The trait of being imperious and overbearing.
