Dogsit in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am dogsitting We are dogsitting
You are dogsitting You are dogsitting
He/She/It is dogsitting They are dogsitting

Dogsit in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have dogsat
You have dogsat
He/She/It has dogsat They have dogsat

Dogsit in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been dogsitting
You have been dogsitting
He/She/It has been dogsitting
They have been dogsitting

Dogsit in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural
I dogsat We dogsat
You dogsat You dogsat
He/She/It dogsat They dogsat

Dogsit in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was dogsitting We were dogsitting
You were dogsitting
He/She/It was dogsitting They were dogsitting

Dogsit in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I **had dogsat**You **had dogsat**He/She/It **had dogsat**They **had dogsat**

Dogsit in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been dogsitting
You had been dogsitting
He/She/It had been dogsitting
They had been dogsitting

Dogsit in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will dogsit
You will dogsit
He/She/It will dogsit
They will dogsit

Dogsit in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be dogsitting
You will be dogsitting
He/She/It will be dogsitting
They will be dogsitting

Dogsit in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have dogsat
You will have dogsat
He/She/It will have dogsat They will have dogsat

Dogsit in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been dogsitting
You will have been dogsitting
He/She/It will have been dogsitting
They will have been dogsitting
