## Synonyms of "Doorway" as a noun (10 Words)

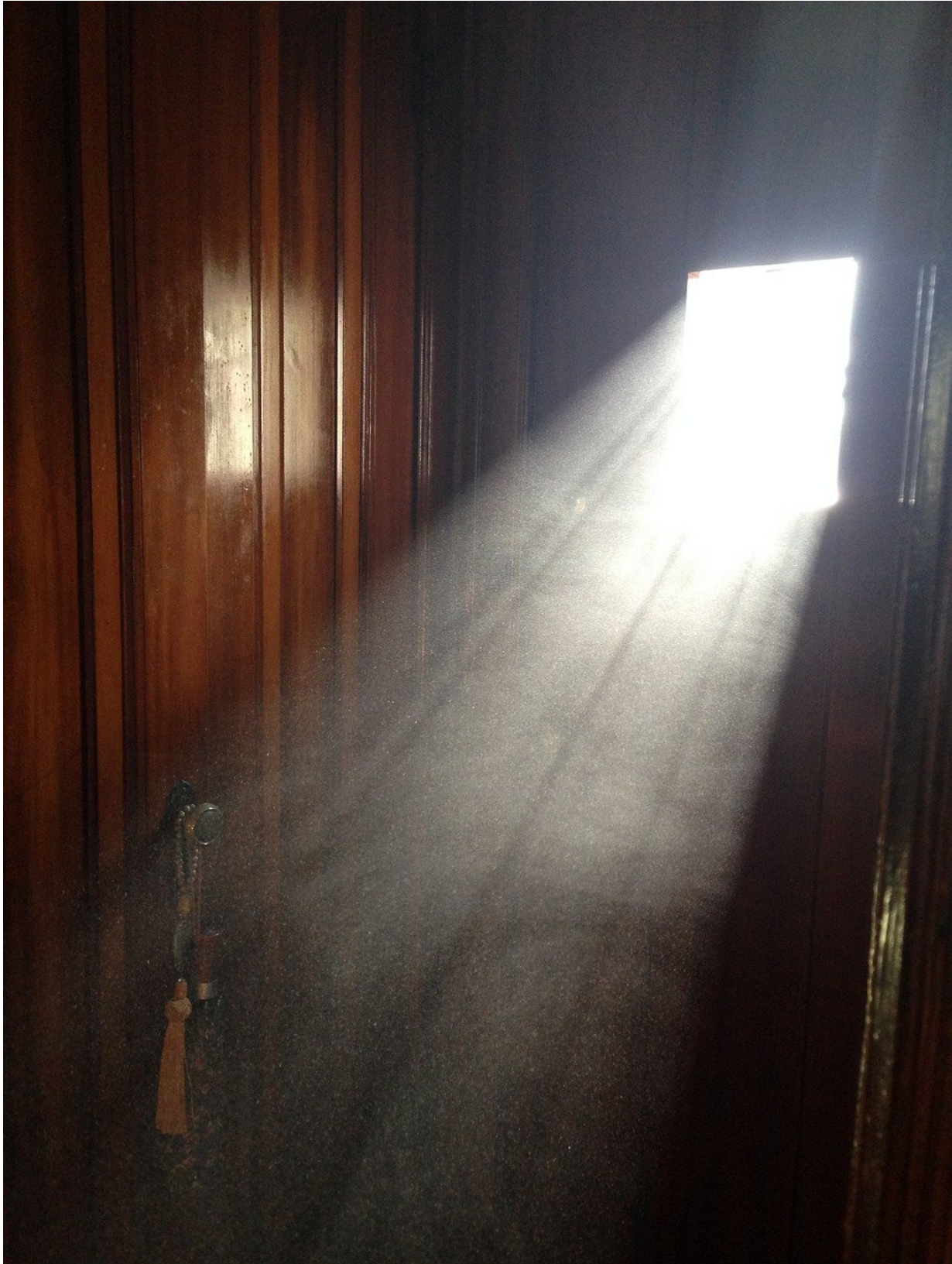
- door** The entrance the space in a wall through which you enter or leave a room or building the space that a door can close.  
*We closed the **door** to Haitian immigrants.*
- egress** The action of going out of or leaving a place.  
*A narrow **egress**.*
- entrance** The right, means, or opportunity to enter somewhere or be a member of an institution, society, or other body.  
*Her final **entrance** is as a triumphant princess.*
- entry** The act of entering.  
*More young people are postponing their **entry** into full time work.*
- exit** A place for traffic to leave a major road or roundabout.  
*An emergency **exit**.*
- hatch** A movable barrier covering a hatchway.  
*A spare wheel mounted on the rear **hatch**.*

- opening** The act of opening something.  
*The **opening** established the basic theme.*
- portal** A website or web page providing access or links to other sites.  
*The **portals** of the cathedral.*
- room access** Opportunity for.
- threshold** A strip of wood or stone forming the bottom of a doorway and crossed in entering a house or room.  
*He stood on the **threshold** of Sheila s bedroom.*

## Associations of "Doorway" (30 Words)

<b>anteroom</b>	A large room in an officers' mess, typically adjacent to the dining room.
<b>brink</b>	The extreme edge of land before a steep slope or a body of water. <i>The country was on the <b>brink</b> of a constitutional crisis.</i>
<b>bungalow</b>	(in SE Asia) a large detached house with more than one storey.
<b>ceiling</b>	(meteorology) altitude of the lowest layer of clouds. <i>The books were stacked from floor to <b>ceiling</b>.</i>
<b>cottage</b>	(in the context of casual homosexual encounters) a public toilet. <i>They said that at some point in their lives they ve <b>cottaged</b> or cruised in parks.</i>
<b>door</b>	A doorway. <i>She walked through the <b>door</b>.</i>
<b>doorstep</b>	The sill of a door; a horizontal piece of wood or stone that forms the bottom of a doorway and offers support when passing through a doorway. <i><b>Doorstep</b> sandwiches.</i>
<b>exit</b>	Used as a stage direction in a play to indicate that an actor leaves the stage. <i>She slipped out by the rear <b>exit</b>.</i>
<b>facade</b>	The principal front of a building, that faces on to a street or open space. <i>The house has a half timbered <b>facade</b>.</i>
<b>foyer</b>	A large entrance or reception room or area. <i>The <b>foyer</b> of the concert hall.</i>
<b>gate</b>	A gateway. <i>They were opening the <b>gates</b> of their country wide to the enemy.</i>
<b>hall</b>	A large and imposing house. <i><b>Halls</b> of learning.</i>
<b>hallway</b>	An interior passage or corridor onto which rooms open.
<b>homestead</b>	Settle land given by the government and occupy it as a homestead.
<b>house</b>	The people living in a house a household. <i>She felt she had to get out of the <b>house</b>.</i>
<b>jamb</b>	Upright consisting of a vertical side member of a door or window frame. <i>He leaned against the door <b>jamb</b>.</i>
<b>lintel</b>	Horizontal beam used as a finishing piece over a door or window.
<b>lobby</b>	In the UK lobby correspondents collectively. <i>Members of the anti abortion <b>lobby</b>.</i>

<b><u>mansion</u></b>	A terrace or mansion block. <i>Carlyle <b>Mansions</b>.</i>
<b>mews</b>	Street lined with buildings that were originally private stables but have been remodeled as dwellings. <i>A <b>mews</b> house.</i>
<b>passageway</b>	A passage between rooms or between buildings. <i>The palace was full of secret <b>passageways</b>.</i>
<b><u>porch</u></b>	A structure attached to the exterior of a building often forming a covered entrance. <i>The north <b>porch</b> of Hereford Cathedral.</i>
<b><u>residence</u></b>	Any address at which you dwell more than temporarily. <i>A person can have several <b>residences</b>.</i>
<b><u>roof</u></b>	Function as the roof of. <i><b>Roof</b> timbers.</i>
<b><u>tenement</u></b>	A run-down apartment house barely meeting minimal standards.
<b>terrace</b>	Provide a house with a terrace. <i>Breakfast is served on the <b>terrace</b>.</i>
<b>threshold</b>	The starting point for a new state or experience. <i>She was on the <b>threshold</b> of a dazzling career.</i>
<b>treetop</b>	The upper branches and leaves of a tree or other plant.
<b>verge</b>	An extreme limit beyond which something specified will happen. <i>His behavior <b>verges</b> on the criminal.</i>
<b><u>window</u></b>	A pane of glass in a window. <i>The ball shattered the <b>window</b>.</i>
