- *The entrance (the space in a wall) through which you enter or leave a room or building; the space that a door can close.*

| egress | The action of going out of or leaving a place. <i>A narrow egress.</i> |
| <u>entrance</u> | The right, means, or opportunity to enter somewhere or be a member of an institution, society, or other body. <i>Her final entrance is as a triumphant princess.</i> |
| entry | The act of entering. <i>More young people are postponing their entry into full time work.</i> |
| <u>exit</u> | A place for traffic to leave a major road or roundabout. <i>An emergency exit.</i> |
| hatch | A movable barrier covering a hatchway. <i>A spare wheel mounted on the rear hatch.</i> |

- opening** The act of opening something.
*The **opening** established the basic theme.*
- portal** A website or web page providing access or links to other sites.
*The **portals** of the cathedral.*
- room access** Opportunity for.
- threshold** A strip of wood or stone forming the bottom of a doorway and crossed in entering a house or room.
*He stood on the **threshold** of Sheila's bedroom.*

| anteroom | A large room in an officers' mess, typically adjacent to the dining room. |
| <u>brink</u> | The extreme edge of land before a steep slope or a body of water. <i>The country was on the brink of a constitutional crisis.</i> |
| <u>bungalow</u> | (in SE Asia) a large detached house with more than one storey. |
| <u>ceiling</u> | (meteorology) altitude of the lowest layer of clouds. <i>The books were stacked from floor to ceiling.</i> |
| <u>cottage</u> | (in the context of casual homosexual encounters) a public toilet. <i>They said that at some point in their lives they ve cottaged or cruised in parks.</i> |
| <u>door</u> | A doorway. <i>She walked through the door.</i> |
| doorstep | The sill of a door; a horizontal piece of wood or stone that forms the bottom of a doorway and offers support when passing through a doorway. <i>Doorstep sandwiches.</i> |
| <u>exit</u> | Used as a stage direction in a play to indicate that an actor leaves the stage. <i>She slipped out by the rear exit.</i> |
| <u>facade</u> | The principal front of a building, that faces on to a street or open space. <i>The house has a half timbered facade.</i> |
| foyer | A large entrance or reception room or area. <i>The foyer of the concert hall.</i> |
| <u>gate</u> | A gateway. <i>They were opening the gates of their country wide to the enemy.</i> |
| <u>hall</u> | A large and imposing house. <i>Halls of learning.</i> |
| hallway | An interior passage or corridor onto which rooms open. |
| homestead | Settle land given by the government and occupy it as a homestead. |
| house | The people living in a house a household. <i>She felt she had to get out of the house.</i> |
| jamb | Upright consisting of a vertical side member of a door or window frame. <i>He leaned against the door jamb.</i> |
| lintel | Horizontal beam used as a finishing piece over a door or window. |
| <u>lobby</u> | In the UK lobby correspondents collectively. <i>Members of the anti abortion lobby.</i> |

| <u>mansion</u> | A terrace or mansion block. <i>Carlyle Mansions.</i> |
| mews | Street lined with buildings that were originally private stables but have been remodeled as dwellings. <i>A mews house.</i> |
| passageway | A passage between rooms or between buildings. <i>The palace was full of secret passageways.</i> |
| <u>porch</u> | A structure attached to the exterior of a building often forming a covered entrance. <i>The north porch of Hereford Cathedral.</i> |
| <u>residence</u> | Any address at which you dwell more than temporarily. <i>A person can have several residences.</i> |
| <u>roof</u> | Function as the roof of. <i>Roof timbers.</i> |
| <u>tenement</u> | A run-down apartment house barely meeting minimal standards. |
| terrace | Provide a house with a terrace. <i>Breakfast is served on the terrace.</i> |
| threshold | The starting point for a new state or experience. <i>She was on the threshold of a dazzling career.</i> |
| treetop | The upper branches and leaves of a tree or other plant. |
| verge | An extreme limit beyond which something specified will happen. <i>His behavior verges on the criminal.</i> |
| <u>window</u> | A pane of glass in a window. <i>The ball shattered the window.</i> |
