Definitions of "Doppelganger" as a noun

According to the <u>Oxford Dictionary of English</u>, "doppelganger" as a noun can have the following definitions:

- An apparition or double of a living person.
- A ghostly double of a living person that haunts its living counterpart.





Synonyms of "Doppelganger" as a noun (7 Words)

<u>phantom</u>	Denoting a financial arrangement or transaction which has been invented for fraudulent purposes. <i>He tried to clear the phantoms from his head and grasp reality.</i>
<u>presence</u>	The state or fact of existing, occurring, or being present. The US would maintain a presence in the Indian Ocean region.
<u>shadow</u>	Used in reference to proximity, ominous oppressiveness, or sadness and gloom. <i>This fine looking commanding man had become a</i> shadow <i>of his former self.</i>
soul	A person's moral or emotional nature or sense of identity. In the depths of her soul she knew he would betray her.
<u>spectre</u>	A ghost. A dread of spectre s and witches affected every aspect of daily life.
CHITH	A fundamental emotional and activating principle determining one's character. <i>As I sat alone in that corridor my</i> spirit <i>s were low.</i>



wraith Used in reference to a pale, thin, or insubstantial person or thing. *A sea breeze was sending a grey* wraith of smoke up the slopes.
