Definitions of "Doppelganger" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “doppelganger” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *An apparition or double of a living person.*
- *A ghostly double of a living person that haunts its living counterpart.*



Synonyms of "Doppelganger" as a noun (7 Words)

- phantom** Denoting a financial arrangement or transaction which has been invented for fraudulent purposes.
*He tried to clear the **phantoms** from his head and grasp reality.*
- presence** The state or fact of existing, occurring, or being present.
*The US would maintain a **presence** in the Indian Ocean region.*
- shadow** Used in reference to proximity, ominous oppressiveness, or sadness and gloom.
*This fine looking commanding man had become a **shadow** of his former self.*
- soul** A person's moral or emotional nature or sense of identity.
*In the depths of her **soul** she knew he would betray her.*
- spectre** A ghost.
*A dread of **spectres** and witches affected every aspect of daily life.*
- spirit** A fundamental emotional and activating principle determining one's character.
*As I sat alone in that corridor my **spirits** were low.*

wraith

Used in reference to a pale, thin, or insubstantial person or thing.
*A sea breeze was sending a grey **wraith** of smoke up the slopes.*
