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Associations of "Double edged sword" (30 Words)

angle	Move or proceed at an angle. <i>The supporting frame is usually of aluminium angle bolted together.</i>
bevel	Cut a bevel on shape to a bevel. <i>Bevel the surface.</i>
bifocal	A pair of glasses with bifocal lenses. <i>Bifocal eyeglasses.</i>
brandish	The act of waving. <i>Brandish a sword.</i>
cudgel	Strike with a cudgel. <i>They would lie in wait and cudgel her to death.</i>
dagger	A moth with a dark dagger shaped marking on the forewing. <i>He drew his dagger and stabbed the leader.</i>
dual	The dual number. <i>Dual language texts in English and Italian.</i>
hemline	The line formed by the lower edge of a skirt or coat. <i>Modest dress means that hemlines must be below the knee.</i>
lancet	A lancet arch or window. <i>A lancet clock.</i>
longitudinal	Running lengthwise. <i>A longitudinal study of ten patients.</i>
margin	Annotate or summarize a text in the margins. <i>There was no margin for error.</i>
multiple	A shop with branches in many places, especially one selling a specific type of product. <i>Multiple ownership.</i>

periphery	A marginal or secondary position in, or aspect of, a group, subject, or sphere of activity. <i>New buildings on the periphery of the hospital site.</i>
perpendicular	Perpendicular position or direction. <i>The perpendicular cliff.</i>
pike	Used in names of predatory fish with large teeth other than the true pike e.g. garpike.
plural	The plural number. <i>Nouns with irregular plurals.</i>
<u>precipice</u>	A very steep rock face or cliff, especially a tall one. <i>We swerved toward the edge of the precipice.</i>
protuberance	Something that bulges out or is protuberant or projects from its surroundings. <i>The occipital protuberance was well developed.</i>
quadruple	A quadruple number or amount. <i>A quadruple murder.</i>
reversible	A garment (especially a coat) that can be worn inside out (with either side of the cloth showing). <i>The entropy change is zero only in the limiting case of a reversible process.</i>
rim	Roll around the rim of. <i>The ball rimmed the basket.</i>
sextuple	Consisting of six parts or things.
<u>side</u>	Take sides for or against siding against the current candidate. <i>A pair of shoes one side winged by a bullet.</i>
ternary	Using three as a base. <i>A ternary operation.</i>
<u>times</u>	Multiply (a number). <i>It was a sign of the times.</i>
<u>trinity</u>	The union of the Father and Son and Holy Ghost in one Godhead. <i>The wine was the first of a trinity of three excellent vintages.</i>
<u>triple</u>	Hit a triple. <i>Grain prices were expected to triple.</i>
verge	An extreme limit beyond which something specified will happen. <i>They came down to the verge of the lake.</i>
<u>ward</u>	Admit to or care for in a hospital ward. <i>The ward and care of the Crown.</i>
