Singular Plural

I double-park
You double-park
He/She/It double-parks
They double-park

Double-park in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am double-parking We are double-parking
You are double-parking You are double-parking
He/She/It is double-parking They are double-parking

Double-park in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have double-parked We have double-parked You have double-parked He/She/It has double-parked They have double-parked

Double-park in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been double-parking
You have been double-parking
He/She/It has been double-parking
They have been double-parking

Double-park in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I double-parked We double-parked
You double-parked You double-parked
He/She/It double-parked They double-parked

Double-park in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was double-parking We were double-parking
You were double-parking
He/She/It was double-parking They were double-parking

Double-park in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had double-parked We had double-parked
You had double-parked You had double-parked
He/She/It had double-parked They had double-parked

Double-park in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been double-parking
You had been double-parking
He/She/It had been double-parking
They had been double-parking

Double-park in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will double-park
You will double-park
He/She/It will double-park
They will double-park

Double-park in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

I will be double-parking
You will be double-parking
He/She/It will be double-parking
They will be double-parking
