## Associations of "Double standard" (30 Words)

<b>average</b>	Approximating the statistical norm or average or expected value. <i>The number of hours I work per work <b>averages</b> out to 40.</i>
<b><u>calculate</u></b>	Judge to be probable. <i>I <b>calculate</b> it s pretty difficult to git edication down there.</i>
<b>criterion</b>	A basis for comparison; a reference point against which other things can be evaluated. <i>They award a green label to products that meet certain environmental criteria.</i>
<b>doubled</b>	Twice as great or many. <i>The dose is <b>doubled</b>.</i>
<b><u>dual</u></b>	Convert a road into a dual carriageway. <i><b>Dual</b> controls for pilot and copilot.</i>
<b>four</b>	A playing card or domino or die whose upward face shows four pips.
<b>median</b>	Denoting the middle term or mean of the middle two terms of a series arranged in order of magnitude For example the median number of the series 55 62 76 85 93 is 76. <i>The <b>median</b> value of 17 20 and 36 is 20.</i>
<b><u>multiple</u></b>	Having or involving several parts, elements, or members. <i>The major food <b>multiples</b>.</i>
<b><u>number</u></b>	A numbered item in a series. <i>The <b>number</b> of parameters is small.</i>
<b>one</b>	Being a single entity made by combining separate components. <i>They had lunch at <b>one</b>.</i>
<b>pirouette</b>	Perform a pirouette. <i>She <b>pirouetted</b> and made a bow.</i>
<b>plural</b>	A plural word or form. <i>Nouns with irregular <b>plurals</b>.</i>

<b>quadruple</b>	A quadruple number or amount. <i>His stock earning <b>quadrupled</b>.</i>
<b>quartet</b>	A composition for a quartet. <i>A Beethoven <b>quartet</b>.</i>
<b>redouble</b>	Make twice as great or intense. <i>The noise doubled and <b>redoubled</b>.</i>
<b>sextet</b>	A composition for a sextet. <i>A <b>sextet</b> of new releases.</i>
<b>sextuple</b>	Six times as much or as many.
<b>six</b>	A playing card or domino or die whose upward face shows six pips.
<b>sixth</b>	The musical interval between one note and another six notes away from it.
<b>ten</b>	One of four playing cards in a deck with ten pips on the face.
<b>ternary</b>	Using three as a base. <i>A <b>ternary</b> operation.</i>
<a href="#"><u>three</u></a>	One of four playing cards in a deck having three pips.
<a href="#"><u>times</u></a>	A more or less definite period of time now or previously present. <i>You <b>times</b> the six by four to get twenty four.</i>
<b>touchstone</b>	A piece of fine-grained dark schist or jasper formerly used for testing alloys of gold by observing the colour of the mark which they made on it. <i>They tend to regard grammar as the <b>touchstone</b> of all language performance.</i>
<a href="#"><u>triad</u></a>	Three people considered as a unit. <i>The <b>triad</b> of medication diet and exercise are necessary in diabetes care.</i>
<b>trillion</b>	The number that is represented as a one followed by 12 zeros. <i>In England they call a quintillion a <b>trillion</b>.</i>
<a href="#"><u>trinity</u></a>	The cardinal number that is the sum of one and one and one. <i>God is said to be <b>trinity</b> in unity.</i>
<a href="#"><u>triple</u></a>	Hit a triple. <i>He <b>tripled</b> into right field.</i>
<b>twice</b>	To double the degree. <i>The earl married <b>twice</b>.</i>
<b>twofold</b>	Having more than one decidedly dissimilar aspects or qualities- R.W.Emerson. <i>The price increased <b>twofold</b> last year.</i>
