average	Approximating the statistical norm or average or expected value. <i>The number of hours I work per work averages out to 40.</i>
<u>calculate</u>	Judge to be probable. <i>I calculate it s pretty difficult to git edication down there.</i>
criterion	A basis for comparison; a reference point against which other things can be evaluated. <i>They award a green label to products that meet certain environmental criteria.</i>
doubled	Twice as great or many. <i>The dose is doubled.</i>
<u>dual</u>	Convert a road into a dual carriageway. <i>Dual controls for pilot and copilot.</i>
four	A playing card or domino or die whose upward face shows four pips.
median	Denoting the middle term or mean of the middle two terms of a series arranged in order of magnitude For example the median number of the series 55 62 76 85 93 is 76. <i>The median value of 17 20 and 36 is 20.</i>
<u>multiple</u>	Having or involving several parts, elements, or members. <i>The major food multiples.</i>
<u>number</u>	A numbered item in a series. <i>The number of parameters is small.</i>
one	Being a single entity made by combining separate components. <i>They had lunch at one.</i>
pirouette	Perform a pirouette. <i>She pirouetted and made a bow.</i>
plural	A plural word or form. <i>Nouns with irregular plurals.</i>

quadruple	A quadruple number or amount. <i>His stock earning quadrupled.</i>
quartet	A composition for a quartet. <i>A Beethoven quartet.</i>
redouble	Make twice as great or intense. <i>The noise doubled and redoubled.</i>
sextet	A composition for a sextet. <i>A sextet of new releases.</i>
sextuple	Six times as much or as many.
six	A playing card or domino or die whose upward face shows six pips.
sixth	The musical interval between one note and another six notes away from it.
ten	One of four playing cards in a deck with ten pips on the face.
ternary	Using three as a base. <i>A ternary operation.</i>
three	One of four playing cards in a deck having three pips.
times	A more or less definite period of time now or previously present. <i>You times the six by four to get twenty four.</i>
touchstone	A piece of fine-grained dark schist or jasper formerly used for testing alloys of gold by observing the colour of the mark which they made on it. <i>They tend to regard grammar as the touchstone of all language performance.</i>
triad	Three people considered as a unit. <i>The triad of medication diet and exercise are necessary in diabetes care.</i>
trillion	The number that is represented as a one followed by 12 zeros. <i>In England they call a quintillion a trillion.</i>
trinity	The cardinal number that is the sum of one and one and one. <i>God is said to be trinity in unity.</i>
triple	Hit a triple. <i>He tripled into right field.</i>
twice	To double the degree. <i>The earl married twice.</i>
twofold	Having more than one decidedly dissimilar aspects or qualities- R.W.Emerson. <i>The price increased twofold last year.</i>
