Disadvantaged groups such as the unemployed.

exploited (of persons) taken advantage of.

Lacking in or deprived of strength or power.

Subject to harsh and authoritarian treatment. <u>oppressed</u>

Oppressed by a sense of failure.

Without ability, influence, or power. powerless

Troops were **powerless** to stop last night s shooting.

Lying stretched out on the ground with one's face downwards. prostrate

There was a man praying before an idol lying **prostrate**.

(of a thought or desire) kept suppressed and unconscious in one's mind. repressed

Repressed rage turned his face scarlet.

Quieted and brought under control. subdued

Children were **subdued** and silent.

Reduced to submission. subjugated **Subjugated** peoples.

under the heel Lower in rank, power, or authority.

underprivileged Lacking the rights and advantages of other members of society. Needy and **underprivileged** members of the community.

victimized (of persons) taken advantage of.
