## The Forms of Drag

Infinitive	<b>to drag</b>
Present Tense	<b>drag / drags</b>
Past Tense	<b>dragged or, in some dialects, drug</b>
Present Participle	<b>dragging</b>
Past Participle	<b>dragged or, in some dialects, drug</b>

## Conjugate Drag

### Drag in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

**Singular      Plural**

I **drag**                      We **drag**  
You **drag**                  You **drag**  
He/She/It **drags**      They **drag**

**Drag in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular                      Plural**

I **am dragging**              We **are dragging**  
You **are dragging**          You **are dragging**  
He/She/It **is dragging**      They **are dragging**

**Drag in Present Perfect Tense**

I **have dragged or, in some dialects, drug**      We **have dragged or, in some dialects, drug**
