## Associations of "Dragged" (30 Words)

<b>allure</b>	Dispose or incline or entice to. <i>Will sponsors really be <b>allured</b> by such opportunities.</i>
<b>anchorage</b>	An anchorite’s dwelling place. <i>The mother provides emotional <b>anchorage</b> for the entire family.</i>
<b>attract</b>	Be attractive to. <i>I am not <b>attracted</b> to him at all.</i>
<b>barge</b>	Transport by barge on a body of water. <i>Just <b>barge</b> the other skater off the ball.</i>
<b>cart</b>	Convey or put in a cart or similar vehicle. <i>Seven demonstrators were <b>carted</b> away by the police.</i>
<b>draw</b>	An act of drawing on a cigarette or cigar. <i>The museum has turned out to be a big <b>draw</b> for school children in the city.</i>
<b><u>dredge</u></b>	Clear the bed of a harbour river or other area of water by scooping out mud weeds and rubbish with a dredge. <i>Mud was <b>dredged</b> out of the harbour.</i>
<b>drone</b>	A musical instrument or part of one sounding a continuous note of low pitch in particular also drone pipe a pipe in a bagpipe or also drone string a string in an instrument such as a hurdy gurdy or a sitar. <i>He reached for another beer while Jim <b>droned</b> on.</i>
<b><u>elicit</u></b>	Evoke or draw out (a reaction, answer, or fact) from someone. <i>I tried to <b>elicit</b> a smile from Joanna.</i>
<b>embroil</b>	Involve (someone) deeply in an argument, conflict, or difficult situation. <i>What merit do you claim for having <b>embroiled</b> everything in which you are concerned.</i>
<b>engaging</b>	Attracting or delighting. <i>An <b>engaging</b> smile.</i>
<b><u>entice</u></b>	Attract or tempt by offering pleasure or advantage. <i>The treat is offered to <b>entice</b> the dog to eat.</i>

<b>gravitational</b>	Denoting a forceful attraction or movement towards something. <i>The <b>gravitational</b> field of the comet is very weak.</i>
<b>haul</b>	The act of drawing or hauling something. <i>Included in her beauty <b>haul</b> were a lot of facial masks.</i>
<b>haulage</b>	A charge for the commercial transport of goods. <i>Road <b>haulage</b>.</i>
<b>ingratiating</b>	Calculated to please or gain favor. <i>A smooth <b>ingratiating</b> manner.</i>
<b>intrigue</b>	Form intrigues for in an underhand manner. <i>I was <b>intrigued</b> by your question.</i>
<b>inviting</b>	Offering the promise of an attractive or enjoyable experience. <i>An <b>inviting</b> offer.</i>
<b>lug</b>	A sail with four corners that is hoisted from a yard that is oblique to the mast. <i>She began to <b>lug</b> her suitcase down the stairs.</i>
<b>lure</b>	Something used to lure fish or other animals into danger so they can be trapped or killed. <i>The <b>lure</b> of the exotic East.</i>
<b>magnet</b>	Physics a device that attracts iron and produces a magnetic field. <i>The beautiful stretch of white sand is a <b>magnet</b> for sun worshippers.</i>
<b>pull</b>	A handle to hold while pulling. <i>The magazine <b>pulled</b> its trick of producing the right issue at the right time.</i>
<b>straighten</b>	Straighten by unrolling. <i>They are asking for help in <b>straightening</b> out their lives.</i>
<b>tempt</b>	Try to seduce. <i>He was <b>tempted</b> out of retirement to save the team from relegation.</i>
<b>tow</b>	A rope or line used to tow a vehicle or boat. <i>She saw Florian <b>towing</b> Nicky along by the hand.</i>
<b>trail</b>	A trailer for a film or broadcast. <i>The torrential rain left a <b>trail</b> of devastation.</i>
<b>tug</b>	Tow a ship by means of a tugboat. <i>She <b>tugged</b> off her boots.</i>
<b>underline</b>	Emphasize (something). <i>She has a white tail and <b>underline</b>.</i>
<b>woo</b>	Try to gain the love of (someone), especially with a view to marriage. <i>China is <b>wooing</b> Russia.</i>
