# **Conjugate Drain**

## **Drain in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>drain</b>	We <b>drain</b>
You <b>drain</b>	You <b>drain</b>
He/She/It <b>drains</b>	They drain

## **Drain in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am draining	We <b>are draining</b>
You <b>are draining</b>	You <b>are draining</b>
He/She/It is draining	They are draining

#### **Drain in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have drained	We have drained
You have drained	You have drained
He/She/It has drained	They have drained

### **Drain in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been draining	We have been draining
You <b>have been draining</b>	You have been draining
He/She/It has been draining	They have been draining

## **Drain in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I drained	We <b>drained</b>
You <b>drained</b>	You <b>drained</b>
He/She/It drained	They <b>drained</b>

## **Drain in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was draining	We <b>were draining</b>
You <b>were draining</b>	You were draining
He/She/It was draining	They were draining

#### **Drain in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had drained	We had drained
You <b>had drained</b>	You had drained
He/She/It had drained	They had drained

#### **Drain in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been draining	We had been draining
You <b>had been draining</b>	You had been draining
He/She/It had been draining	They had been draining

## **Drain in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>will drain</b>	We <b>will drain</b>
You <b>will drain</b>	You <b>will drain</b>
He/She/It will drain	They will drain

## **Drain in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be draining	We <b>will be draining</b>
You <b>will be draining</b>	You <b>will be draining</b>
He/She/It will be draining	They will be draining

#### **Drain in Future Perfect Tense**

#### **Drain in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been draining	We <b>will have been draining</b>
You <b>will have been draining</b>	You <b>will have been draining</b>
He/She/It will have been draining	They will have been draining
