Infinitive	to dramatise
Present Tense	dramatise / dramatises
Past Tense	dramatised
Present Participle	dramatising
Past Participle	dramatised

# **Conjugate Dramatise**

### **Dramatise in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I dramatise	We <b>dramatise</b>
You <b>dramatise</b>	You <b>dramatise</b>
He/She/It <b>dramatises</b>	They <b>dramatise</b>

## **Dramatise in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am dramatising	We are dramatising
You <b>are dramatising</b>	You are dramatising
He/She/It is dramatising	They are dramatising

#### **Dramatise in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have dramatised	We have dramatised
You have dramatised	You have dramatised
He/She/It has dramatised	They have dramatised

## **Dramatise in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been dramatising	We have been dramatising
You <b>have been dramatising</b>	You have been dramatising
He/She/It has been dramatising	They have been dramatising

## **Dramatise in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I dramatised	We <b>dramatised</b>
You <b>dramatised</b>	You <b>dramatised</b>
He/She/It dramatised	They <b>dramatised</b>

## **Dramatise in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was dramatising	We were dramatising
You were dramatising	You were dramatising
He/She/It was dramatising	They were dramatising

#### **Dramatise in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had dramatised	We had dramatised
You had dramatised	You had dramatised
He/She/It had dramatised	They had dramatised

## **Dramatise in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been dramatising	We had been dramatising
You <b>had been dramatising</b>	You <b>had been dramatising</b>
He/She/It had been dramatising	They had been dramatising

## **Dramatise in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will dramatise	We will dramatise
You <b>will dramatise</b>	You <b>will dramatise</b>
He/She/It will dramatise	They will dramatise

## **Dramatise in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be dramatising	We will be dramatising
You <b>will be dramatising</b>	You will be dramatising
He/She/It will be dramatising	They will be dramatising

### **Dramatise in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been dramatising	We <b>will have been dramatising</b>
You <b>will have been dramatising</b>	You will have been dramatising
He/She/It will have been dramatising	They will have been dramatising
