<b>artist</b>	A person who habitually practises a specified reprehensible activity. <i>Rip off <b>artists</b>.</i>
<b>attract</b>	Be attractive to. <i>A campaign to <b>attract</b> more visitors to Shetland.</i>
<b>attraction</b>	The influence exerted by one word on another which causes it to change to an incorrect form, e.g. the wages of sin is (for are) death. <i>The church is the town s main tourist <b>attraction</b>.</i>
<a href="#">caricature</a>	Represent in or produce a caricature of. <i>The drawing <b>caricatured</b> the President.</i>
<b>charcoal</b>	Charcoal used for drawing. <i>With a thick <b>charcoal</b> he traced out the line of the front.</i>
<a href="#">conceivable</a>	Capable of being imagined. <i>A mass uprising was entirely <b>conceivable</b>.</i>
<b>doodle</b>	Make a doodle draw aimlessly. <i>The text was interspersed with <b>doodles</b>.</i>
<b>draft</b>	Select a player for a sports team through the draft. <i>He was <b>drafted</b> in 1938.</i>
<b>drag</b>	A hunt using a drag lure. <i>We <b>dragged</b> the boat up the beach.</i>
<a href="#">drawing</a>	The act of moving a load by drawing or pulling. <i>She took lessons in <b>drawing</b>.</i>
<b>gravitational</b>	Denoting a forceful attraction or movement towards something. <i>For many international companies Russia s <b>gravitational</b> pull is simply too strong to resist.</i>
<a href="#">haul</a>	The act of drawing or hauling something. <i>My plan was to <b>haul</b> offshore well clear of the land.</i>

<b>haulage</b>	The act of drawing or hauling something. <i>Road <b>haulage</b>.</i>
<b>illustrator</b>	A person who draws or creates pictures for magazines, books, advertising, etc.
<b>intrigue</b>	Form intrigues for in an underhand manner. <i>Henry and Louis <b>intrigued</b> with the local nobles.</i>
<b>lug</b>	Carry with difficulty. <i>You ll have to <b>lug</b> this suitcase.</i>
<b><u>magnet</u></b>	Physics a device that attracts iron and produces a magnetic field. <i>The beautiful stretch of white sand is a <b>magnet</b> for sun worshippers.</i>
<b>painter</b>	A person whose job is painting buildings. <i>A German landscape <b>painter</b>.</i>
<b>photography</b>	The occupation of taking and printing photographs or making movies.
<b>picture</b>	Show in or as in a picture. <i>He had no clear <b>picture</b> of himself or his world.</i>
<b>plan</b>	A drawing or diagram made by projection on a horizontal plane especially one showing the layout of a building or one floor of a building. <i>Look at the seating <b>plan</b>.</i>
<b><u>portrait</u></b>	A representation or impression of someone or something in language or on film or television. <i>A <b>portrait</b> of George III.</i>
<b>portraitist</b>	A painter, photographer, etc., who specializes in or is particularly skilled at portraits. <i>Gerda is working as a <b>portraitist</b> of prominent citizens.</i>
<b>portray</b>	Portray in words. <i>Goya wanted to <b>portray</b> his mistress the Duchess of Alba.</i>
<b>portrayal</b>	Representation by drawing or painting etc. <i>The media <b>portrayal</b> of immigration.</i>
<b>pull</b>	A device used for pulling something. <i>His strenuous <b>pulling</b> strained his back.</i>
<b>redesign</b>	The action or process of redesigning something. <i>It was achieved by the <b>redesign</b> of the product.</i>
<b><u>sketch</u></b>	Make a sketch of. <i>You can see how the first movement evolved from the composer s <b>sketches</b>.</i>
<b><u>trail</u></b>	A trailer for a film or broadcast. <i>The defending champions were <b>trailing</b> 10 5 at half time.</i>
