phantasmagorical Characterized by fantastic imagery and incongruous juxtapositions.



Having the qualities of surrealism bizarre.


The incongruous imagery in **surreal** art and literature.

unreal Lacking material form or substance unreal.

Unreal propaganda serving as news.

unsubstantial Having little or no solidity, reality, or factual basis.

A pretty if **unsubstantial** cubist composition.
