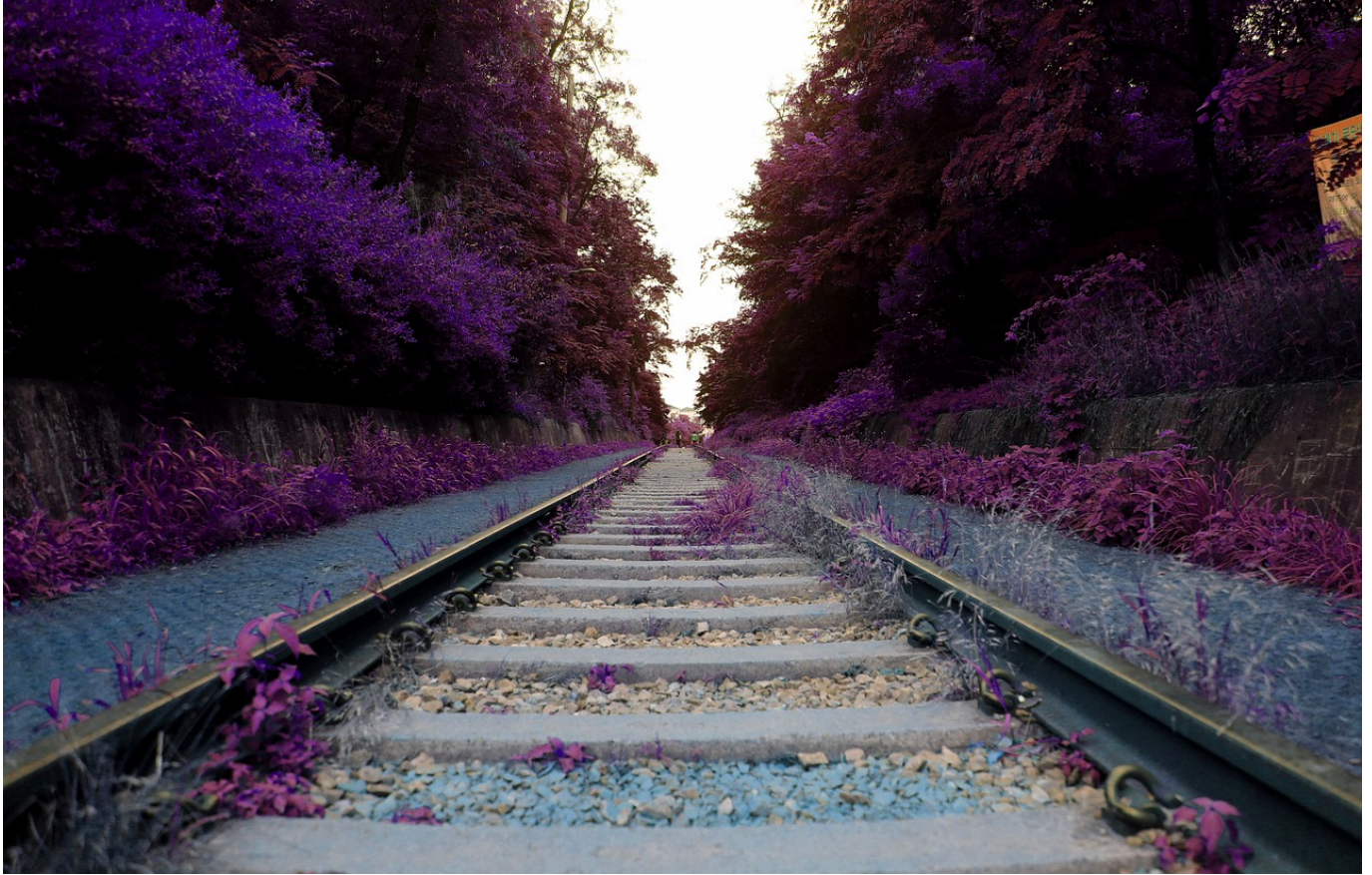

Definitions of "Dreamlike" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “dreamlike” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Having the qualities of a dream; unreal.*
- *Resembling a dream.*



Synonyms of "Dreamlike" as an adjective (10 Words)

chimerical	Produced by a wildly fanciful imagination- Douglas Bush. <i>His Utopia is not a chimerical commonwealth but a practical improvement on what already exists.</i>
ethereal	Characterized by unusual lightness and delicacy. <i>Her ethereal beauty.</i>
illusionary	Marked by or producing illusion. <i>Illusionary stage effects.</i>
illusive	Based on or having the nature of an illusion. <i>An illusive haven.</i>
illusory	Based on illusion; not real. <i>She knew the safety of her room was illusory.</i>
imaginary	Existing only in the imagination. <i>A small child s imaginary friends.</i>
phantasmagorical	Characterized by fantastic imagery and incongruous juxtapositions.

surreal

Having the qualities of surrealism bizarre.
*The incongruous imagery in **surreal** art and literature.*

unreal

Lacking material form or substance unreal.
***Unreal** propaganda serving as news.*

unsubstantial

Having little or no solidity, reality, or factual basis.
*A pretty if **unsubstantial** cubist composition.*



Usage Examples of "Dreamlike" as an adjective

- *She snapped out of her dreamlike state.*
- *Night invested the lake with a dreamlike quality.*
