Drive in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Drive in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural
I am driving We are driving
You are driving You are driving
He/She/It is driving They are driving

Drive in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural
I have driven We have driven
You have driven You have driven
He/She/It has driven They have driven

Drive in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been driving We have been driving

You have been driving They have been driving

He/She/It has been driving They have been driving

Drive in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I drove or (archaic) drave
You drove or (archaic) drave
He/She/It drove or (archaic) drave
They drove or (archaic) drave

Drive in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was driving We were driving
You were driving You were driving
He/She/It was driving They were driving

Drive in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural
I had driven We had driven
You had driven You had driven
He/She/It had driven They had driven

Drive in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been driving
You had been driving
You had been driving
He/She/It had been driving They had been driving

Drive in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural
I will drive We will drive
You will drive You will drive
He/She/It will drive They will drive

Drive in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be driving
You will be driving
He/She/It will be driving
They will be driving

Drive in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have driven
You will have driven
He/She/It will have driven
They will have driven

Drive in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been driving
You will have been driving
He/She/It will have been driving
They will have been driving
