- imbiber** A person who drinks alcoholic beverages (especially to excess).
- inebriate** A drunkard.
*He was marked down as an **inebriate**.*
- rummy** A card game, sometimes played with two packs, in which the players try to form sets and sequences of cards.
- sot** A habitual drunkard.
- tippler** Someone who drinks liquor repeatedly in small quantities.
- wino** A chronic drinker.
