According to the <u>Oxford Dictionary of English</u>, "duality" as a noun can have the following definitions:


- The interchangeability of the roles of points and planes in the theorems of projective geometry.
- The property of matter and electromagnetic radiation that is characterized by the fact that some properties can be explained best by wave theory and others by particle theory.
- The property of two theorems, expressions, etc., of being dual to each other.
- The quality or condition of being dual.
- The quantum-mechanical property of being regardable as both a wave and a particle.
- An instance of opposition or contrast between two concepts or two aspects of something; a dualism.
- Being twofold; a classification into two opposed parts or subclasses.
- (geometry) the interchangeability of the roles of points and planes in the theorems of projective geometry.
- (physics) the property of matter and electromagnetic radiation that is characterized by the fact that some properties can be explained best by wave theory and others by particle theory.
