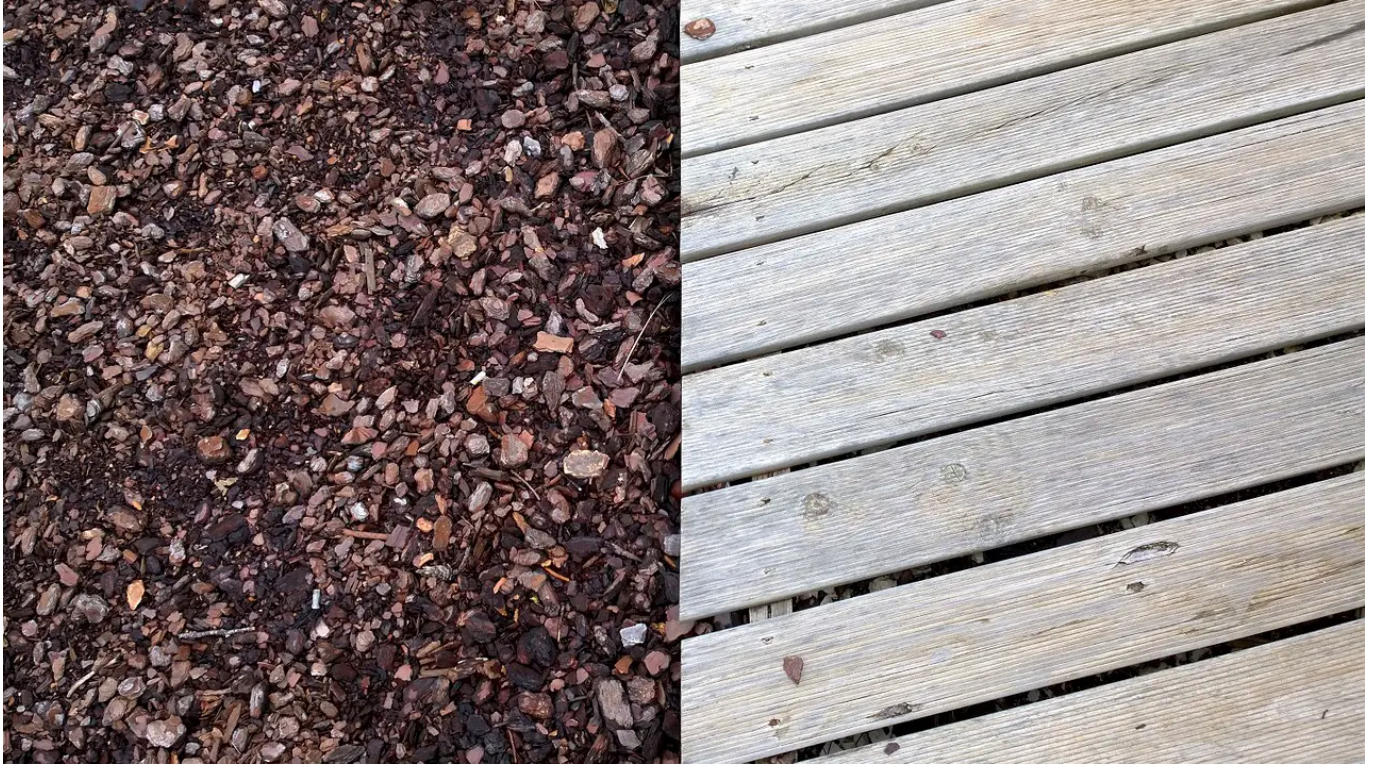

- *The property of two theorems, expressions, etc., of being dual to each other.*
- *The quality or condition of being dual.*
- *The quantum-mechanical property of being regardable as both a wave and a particle.*
- *An instance of opposition or contrast between two concepts or two aspects of something; a dualism.*
- *Being twofold; a classification into two opposed parts or subclasses.*
- *(geometry) the interchangeability of the roles of points and planes in the theorems of projective geometry.*
- *(physics) the property of matter and electromagnetic radiation that is characterized by the fact that some properties can be explained best by wave theory and others by particle theory.*

### **duplexity**

The quality of being dual or double.

*The famous **duplexity** of Beethoven s works.*

### **wave-particle duality**

The property of matter and electromagnetic radiation that is characterized by the fact that some properties can be explained best by wave theory and others by particle theory.
