## Associations of "Dwarfed" (30 Words)

<b>acrobat</b>	An entertainer who performs spectacular gymnastic feats.
<b>brat</b>	A very troublesome child. <i>Presumably this is where people dump their <b>brats</b> so they can shop in relative peace.</i>
<b>buffoon</b>	A ridiculous but amusing person; a clown.
<b>chimpanzee</b>	A great ape with large ears, mainly black coloration, and lighter skin on the face, native to the forests of west and central Africa. Chimpanzees show advanced behaviour such as the making and using of tools.
<b>clown</b>	Act as or like a clown. <i>A circus <b>clown</b>.</i>
<b>colossus</b>	A person of exceptional importance and reputation. <i>The Russian Empire was the <b>colossus</b> of European politics.</i>
<b>devil</b>	Expressing surprise or annoyance in various questions or exclamations. <i>They prefer voting for <b>devils</b> than for decent men.</i>
<b>enormous</b>	Very large in size, quantity, or extent. <i>An <b>enormous</b> boulder.</i>
<b>fairy</b>	A small imaginary being of human form that has magical powers, especially a female one. <i><b>Fairy</b> gold.</i>
<b>fiend</b>	An evil spirit or demon. <i>Britain s most notorious sex <b>fiend</b>.</i>
<b>fool</b>	Make a fool or dupe of. <i>She had been <b>fooling</b> herself in thinking she could remain indifferent.</i>
<b>gargantuan</b>	Enormous. <i>A <b>gargantuan</b> appetite.</i>

<b>giant</b>	Used in names of very large animals and plants e g giant hogweed giant tortoise. <i>A <b>giant</b> meteorite.</i>
<b>gnome</b>	A small garden ornament in the form of a bearded man with a pointed hat. <i>The <b>gnomes</b> of Zurich.</i>
<b>imp</b>	A small, mischievous devil or sprite. <i>A cheeky young <b>imp</b>.</i>
<b>jugling</b>	The act of rearranging things to give a misleading impression.
<b>lore</b>	A body of traditions and knowledge on a subject or held by a particular group, typically passed from person to person by word of mouth. <i>The jinns of Arabian <b>lore</b>.</i>
<b>magic</b>	An illusory feat considered magical by naive observers. <i>He s been working his <b>magic</b> on New Zealand movies for the past two decades.</i>
<b>mischievous</b>	Deliberately causing harm or damage. <i>A <b>mischievous</b> grin.</i>
<b>monkey</b>	A person who is dominated or controlled by another with reference to the monkey traditionally kept by an organ grinder. <i>Don t <b>monkey</b> with that lock.</i>
<b>monster</b>	A cruel wicked and inhuman person. <i>A <b>monster</b> 36lb carp.</i>
<b>ogre</b>	A cruel wicked and inhuman person. <i>It is clear that I am no <b>ogre</b>.</i>
<b>princess</b>	A form of address used by a man to a girl or woman. <i>Stop being such a <b>princess</b>.</i>
<b>pygmy</b>	Used in names of animals and plants that are much smaller than more typical kinds e g pygmy shrew pygmy water lily. <i>Charles VIII of France was a <b>pygmy</b>.</i>
<b>rapscallion</b>	A mischievous person. <i>They were the <b>rapscallions</b> behind this practical joke.</i>
<b>scamp</b>	One who is playfully mischievous. <i>That man was a <b>scamp</b> a damn thief.</i>
<b>sylph</b>	An elemental being believed to inhabit the air. <i>An oh so slim <b>sylph</b> dressed in a black leotard.</i>
<b>tale</b>	A trivial lie. <i>A delightful children s <b>tale</b>.</i>

A hedgehog.
