Dwell in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural
I am dwelling We are dwelling
You are dwelling You are dwelling
He/She/It is dwelling They are dwelling

Dwell in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have dwelt or dwelled (mostly us) We have dwelt or dwelled (mostly us)

You have dwelt or dwelled (mostly us)

He/She/It has dwelt or dwelled (mostly us) They have dwelt or dwelled (mostly us)

Dwell in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been dwelling
You have been dwelling
He/She/It has been dwelling
They have been dwelling

You dwelt or dwelled (mostly us)

Dwell in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was dwelling We were dwelling
You were dwelling You were dwelling
He/She/It was dwelling They were dwelling

Dwell in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had dwelt or dwelled (mostly us)

You had dwelt or dwelled (mostly us)

He/She/It had dwelt or dwelled (mostly us)

We had dwelt or dwelled (mostly us)

You had dwelt or dwelled (mostly us)

They had dwelt or dwelled (mostly us)

Dwell in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been dwelling We had been dwelling
You had been dwelling You had been dwelling
He/She/It had been dwelling They had been dwelling

Dwell in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural
I will dwell We will dwell
You will dwell You will dwell
He/She/It will dwell They will dwell

Dwell in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be dwelling We will be dwelling
You will be dwelling You will be dwelling
He/She/It will be dwelling They will be dwelling
