

# dyscrasied or (more rarely) dyscrasyed

#### The past tense of dyscrasy is dyscrasied or (more rarely) dyscrasyed

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# **The Forms of Dyscrasy**

Infinitive	to dyscrasy
Present Tense	dyscrasy / *dyscrasies
Past Tense	dyscrasied or (more rarely) dyscrasyed
Present Participle	*dyscrasying
Past Participle	dyscrasied or (more rarely) dyscrasyed

# **Conjugate Dyscrasy**

**Dyscrasy in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense** 



Singular	Plural
I dyscrasy	We <b>dyscrasy</b>
You <b>dyscrasy</b>	You <b>dyscrasy</b>
He/She/It *dyscrasies	They <b>dyscrasy</b>

### **Dyscrasy in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am *dyscrasying	We are *dyscrasying
You are *dyscrasying	You are *dyscrasying
He/She/It is *dyscrasying	They are *dyscrasying

### **Dyscrasy in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have dyscrasied or (more rarely)	We <b>have dyscrasied or (more rarely)</b>
dyscrasyed	dyscrasyed
You <b>have dyscrasied or (more rarely)</b>	You <b>have dyscrasied or (more rarely)</b>
dyscrasyed	dyscrasyed
He/She/It has dyscrasied or (more rarely)	They have dyscrasied or (more rarely)
dyscrasyed	dyscrasyed

# **Dyscrasy in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been *dyscrasying	We have been *dyscrasying
You have been *dyscrasying	You have been *dyscrasying
He/She/It has been *dyscrasying	They have been *dyscrasying

# **Dyscrasy in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I dyscrasied or (more rarely) dyscrasyed	We <b>dyscrasied or (more rarely)</b> dyscrasyed
You <b>dyscrasied or (more rarely)</b> dyscrasyed	You <b>dyscrasied or (more rarely)</b> dyscrasyed



Singular	Plural
He/She/It dyscrasied or (more rarely)	They dyscrasied or (more rarely)
dyscrasyed	dyscrasyed

### **Dyscrasy in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I was *dyscrasying	We were *dyscrasying
You were *dyscrasying	You were *dyscrasying
He/She/It was *dyscrasying	They <b>were *dyscrasying</b>

#### **Dyscrasy in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had dyscrasied or (more rarely)	We <b>had dyscrasied or (more rarely)</b>
dyscrasyed	dyscrasyed
You <b>had dyscrasied or (more rarely)</b>	You <b>had dyscrasied or (more rarely)</b>
dyscrasyed	dyscrasyed
He/She/It had dyscrasied or (more rarely)	They had dyscrasied or (more rarely)
dyscrasyed	dyscrasyed

# **Dyscrasy in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been *dyscrasying	We had been *dyscrasying
You had been *dyscrasying	You <b>had been *dyscrasying</b>
He/She/It had been *dyscrasying	They had been *dyscrasying

### **Dyscrasy in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will dyscrasy	We will dyscrasy
You <b>will dyscrasy</b>	You <b>will dyscrasy</b>
He/She/It will dyscrasy	They will dyscrasy



# **Dyscrasy in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be *dyscrasying	We will be *dyscrasying
You <b>will be *dyscrasying</b>	You <b>will be *dyscrasying</b>
He/She/It will be *dyscrasying	They will be *dyscrasying

### **Dyscrasy in Future Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have dyscrasied or (more rarely)	We <b>will have dyscrasied or (more rarely)</b>
dyscrasyed	dyscrasyed
You will have dyscrasied or (more rarely)	You will have dyscrasied or (more rarely)
dyscrasyed	dyscrasyed
He/She/It <b>will have dyscrasied or (more rarely) dyscrasyed</b>	They <b>will have dyscrasied or (more</b> rarely) dyscrasyed

# **Dyscrasy in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been *dyscrasying	We will have been *dyscrasying
You will have been *dyscrasying	You will have been *dyscrasying
He/She/It will have been *dyscrasying They will have been *dyscrasying
