The Forms of Dyscrasy

Infinitive	to dyscrasy
Present Tense	dyscrasy / *dyscrasies
Past Tense	dyscrasied or (more rarely) dyscrasyed
Present Participle	*dyscrasying
Past Participle	dyscrasied or (more rarely) dyscrasyed

Conjugate Dyscrasy

Dyscrasy in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **dyscrasy**
 You **dyscrasy**
 He/She/It ***dyscrasies** They **dyscrasy**

Dyscrasy in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **am *dyscrasying**
 You **are *dyscrasying**
 He/She/It **is *dyscrasying** They **are *dyscrasying**

Dyscrasy in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have dyscrasied or (more rarely) dyscrasyed**
 You **have dyscrasied or (more rarely) dyscrasyed**
 He/She/It **has dyscrasied or (more rarely) dyscrasyed**
 We **have dyscrasied or (more rarely) dyscrasyed**
 You **have dyscrasied or (more rarely) dyscrasyed**
 They **have dyscrasied or (more rarely) dyscrasyed**

Singular

Plural

I **have been *dyscrasying**
 You **have been *dyscrasying**
 He/She/It **has been *dyscrasying** They **have been *dyscrasying**

Singular

Plural

I **dyscrasied or (more rarely) dyscrasyed**
 You **dyscrasied or (more rarely) dyscrasyed**
 We **dyscrasied or (more rarely) dyscrasyed**
 You **dyscrasied or (more rarely) dyscrasyed**

Singular

He/She/It **dyscrasied or (more rarely) dyscrasyed**

Plural

They **dyscrasied or (more rarely) dyscrasyed**

Dyscrasy in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

I **was *dyscrasying**

You **were *dyscrasying**

He/She/It **was *dyscrasying**

Plural

We **were *dyscrasying**

You **were *dyscrasying**

They **were *dyscrasying**

Dyscrasy in Past Perfect Tense

Singular

I **had dyscrasied or (more rarely) dyscrasyed**

You **had dyscrasied or (more rarely) dyscrasyed**

He/She/It **had dyscrasied or (more rarely) dyscrasyed**

Plural

We **had dyscrasied or (more rarely) dyscrasyed**

You **had dyscrasied or (more rarely) dyscrasyed**

Singular

I **had been *dyscrasying**

You **had been *dyscrasying**

He/She/It **had been *dyscrasying**

Plural

We **had been *dyscrasying**

You **had been *dyscrasying**

They **had been *dyscrasying**

Dyscrasy in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

I **will dyscrasy**

You **will dyscrasy**

He/She/It **will dyscrasy**

Plural

We **will dyscrasy**

You **will dyscrasy**

They **will dyscrasy**

Dyscrasy in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

I will be *dyscrasying

You will be *dyscrasying

He/She/It will be *dyscrasying

Plural

We will be *dyscrasying

You will be *dyscrasying

They will be *dyscrasying

Dyscrasy in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

I will have dyscrasied or (more rarely) dyscrasyed

You will have dyscrasied or (more rarely) dyscrasyed

He/She/It will have dyscrasied or (more rarely) dyscrasyed

Plural

We will have dyscrasied or (more rarely) dyscrasyed

You will have dyscrasied or (more rarely) dyscrasyed

They will have dyscrasied or (more rarely) dyscrasyed

Singular

I will have been *dyscrasying

You will have been *dyscrasying

He/She/It will have been *dyscrasying

Plural

We will have been *dyscrasying

You will have been *dyscrasying

They will have been *dyscrasying
