anxiously	With anxiety or apprehension. We watched <b>anxiously</b> .
<u>ardent</u>	Very enthusiastic or passionate. The <b>ardent</b> flames.
<u>aspire</u>	Direct one's hopes or ambitions towards achieving something Above the domes of loftiest mosques these pinnacles <b>aspire</b> .
await	(of an event or circumstance) be in store for (someone. An eagerly <b>await</b> ed debut.



<u>bide</u>	Dwell. How long must I <b>bide</b> here to wait for the answer.
covetous	Immoderately desirous of acquiring e.g. wealth. <i>He was never <b>covetous</b> before he met her.</i>
desire	Feel or have a desire for want strongly. A man of many <b>desire</b> s.
desirous	Having or characterized by desire. <b>Desirous</b> of finding a quick solution to the problem.
<u>devour</u>	Eat immoderately. He <b>devour</b> ed half of his burger in one bite.
eager	(of a person's expression or tone of voice) keenly expectant or interested. <b>Eager</b> to travel abroad.
earnest	Sincerely earnest. Two girls were in <b>earnest</b> conversation.
enthusiasm	Something that arouses enthusiasm. Her energy and <b>enthusiasm</b> for life.
enthusiastic	Having or showing intense and eager enjoyment, interest, or approval. An <b>enthusiastic</b> response.
<u>envious</u>	Showing extreme cupidity; painfully desirous of another's advantages. An <b>envious</b> glance.
<u>fanaticism</u>	Excessive intolerance of opposing views. <i>The dangers of religious <b>fanaticism</b></i> .
<u>fervent</u>	Hot, burning, or glowing. The <b>fervent</b> heat merely communicated a genial warmth to their half torpid systems.
fervid	Extremely hot- Nathaniel Hawthorne- Frances Trollope. <i>His fervid</i> protestations of love.
greedy	Ardently or excessively desirous. <i>Greedy</i> for money and power.
impassioned	Characterized by intense emotion. An <b>impassioned</b> appeal.
<u>jealous</u>	Feeling or showing a resentful suspicion that one's partner is attracted to or involved with someone else. <i>A jealous lover.</i>
passion	Any object of warm affection or devotion. Oratory in which he gradually works himself up into a <b>passion</b> .



passionate	Having or expressing strong emotions. <i>Passionate</i> pleas for help.
<u>rabid</u>	Having or proceeding from an extreme or fanatical support of or belief in something. She s expecting more <b>rabid</b> support from the home fans.
restlessly	In a restless manner.
torrid	(especially in financial contexts) characterized by intense activity; hard to contain or stop. <i>The world s most torrid economies.</i>
uneasily	In a way that is awkward or incongruous. I shifted <b>uneasily</b> in my seat.
zeal	Prompt willingness. He had an absolute <b>zeal</b> for litigation.
zealotry	Fanatical and uncompromising pursuit of religious, political, or other ideals; fanaticism. <i>He expressed concern about religious</i> <b>zealotry</b> <i>playing an increasing role in</i> <i>politics.</i>
<u>zealous</u>	Having or showing zeal. The council was extremely <b>zealous</b> in the application of the regulations.
