Definitions of "Earnestly" as an adverb

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “earnestly” as an adverb can have the following definitions:

- *In a serious manner.*
- *With sincere and intense conviction; seriously.*

Synonyms of "Earnestly" as an adverb (9 Words)

firmly	In a way that uses steady power or strength. <i>His reputation is now firmly established.</i>
gravely	In a serious or solemn manner. <i>The guard nodded gravely.</i>
in earnest	To or toward the inside of.
intently	With strained or eager attention. <i>He gazed at her intently.</i>
resolutely	With firmness. <i>She resolutely refused to be bullied by those around her.</i>
seriously	In a solemn or considered manner. <i>Was seriously ill.</i>

- sincerely** Written formula for ending a letter.
*I **sincerely** hope that we shall have a change of government.*
- soberly** In a serious, sensible, and solemn manner.
*The citizens lived **soberly** and simply.*
- solemnly** In a formal and dignified manner.
*The players walked **solemnly** off the court.*

Usage Examples of "Earnestly" as an adverb

- *They earnestly hope to come back in the summer.*
- *Talking earnestly with his son.*
