### Definitions of "Earthly" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “earthly” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Used for emphasis.*
- *Relating to humankind's material existence as distinct from a spiritual or heavenly one.*
- *Relating to the earth or human life.*
- *Of or belonging to or characteristic of this earth as distinguished from heaven.*



## Synonyms of "Earthly" as an adjective (17 Words)

- conceivable** Capable of being imagined or grasped mentally.  
*A mass uprising was entirely **conceivable**.*
- feasible** Capable of being done with means at hand and circumstances as they are.  
*It is not **feasible** to put most finds from excavations on public display.*
- human** Having human form or attributes as opposed to those of animals or divine beings.  
***Human** kindness.*
- imaginable** Capable of being imagined.  
*The most spectacular views **imaginable**.*
- likely** Likely but not certain to be or become true or real.  
*A **likely** result.*
- material** Having material or physical form or substance Benjamin Jowett.  
***Material** living standards have risen.*
- materialistic** Marked by materialism.  
*We re living in a highly **materialistic** society.*
- mortal** Denoting a grave sin that is regarded as depriving the soul of divine grace.  
*A **mortal** illness.*

<b><u>mundane</u></b>	Found in the ordinary course of events- Anita Diamant. <i>His <b>mundane</b> humdrum existence.</i>
<b>perceivable</b>	Capable of being apprehended or understood. <i><b>Perceivable</b> through the mist.</i>
<b><u>possible</u></b>	Capable of happening or existing. <i>The <b>possible</b> effects of global warming.</i>
<b><u>secular</u></b>	Occurring once every century or similarly long period (used especially in reference to celebratory games in ancient Rome). <i><b>Secular</b> attitudes to death.</i>
<b>tellurian</b>	Of or inhabiting the earth.
<b>telluric</b>	Of the soil.
<b><u>temporal</u></b>	Characteristic of or devoted to the temporal world as opposed to the spiritual world. <i>The spatial and <b>temporal</b> dimensions of human interference in complex ecosystems.</i>
<b><u>terrestrial</u></b>	(of a planet) similar in size or composition to the earth, especially being one of the four inner planets. <i>A submarine eruption will be much more explosive than its <b>terrestrial</b> counterpart.</i>
<b><u>worldly</u></b>	Very sophisticated especially because of surfeit; versed in the ways of the world. <i>She was much more <b>worldly</b> than Nora and dismissed the slur.</i>

### **aeon**

(Gnosticism) a divine power or nature emanating from the Supreme Being and playing various roles in the operation of the universe.

*He reached the crag **aeons** before I arrived.*

<b>auricular</b>	Of or relating to near the ear. <i>The Catholic doctrine of the necessity of private <b>auricular</b> confession.</i>
<b>buddhism</b>	The teaching of Buddha that life is permeated with suffering caused by desire, that suffering ceases when desire ceases, and that enlightenment obtained through right conduct and wisdom and meditation releases one from desire and suffering and rebirth.
<b>buddhist</b>	Of or relating to or supporting Buddhism.
<b>calvary</b>	Any experience that causes intense suffering.
<a href="#">castle</a>	A magnificent and imposing old mansion. <i>Both of the players <b>castled</b> on the queenside.</i>
<a href="#">church</a>	Perform a special church rite or service for. <i>Our <b>church</b> is hosting a picnic next week.</i>
<b>confucianism</b>	The teachings of Confucius emphasizing love for humanity; high value given to learning and to devotion to family (including ancestors); peace; justice; influenced the traditional culture of China.
<b>diehard</b>	A person who strongly opposes change or who continues to support something in spite of opposition. <i>A <b>diehard</b> Yankees fan.</i>
<b>ecosystem</b>	(in general use) a complex network or interconnected system. <i>The marine <b>ecosystem</b> of the northern Gulf had suffered irreparable damage.</i>
<b>eon</b>	(Gnosticism) a divine power or nature emanating from the Supreme Being and playing various roles in the operation of the universe. <i>Oh that happened <b>eons</b> ago.</i>
<b>layperson</b>	A non-ordained member of a Church. <i>His highly successful lectures were meant for an audience of <b>laypersons</b> interested in the natural sciences.</i>
<b>majestically</b>	With impressive beauty or scale. <i>The steep slopes of the valley floor rise <b>majestically</b> skywards.</i>
<b>materialistic</b>	Conforming to the standards and conventions of the middle class. <i>We re living in a highly <b>materialistic</b> society.</i>
<b>mosque</b>	A Muslim place of worship that usually has a minaret.
<a href="#">mundane</a>	Belonging to this earth or world; not ideal or heavenly. <i><b>Mundane</b> affairs.</i>
<b>overland</b>	Drive (livestock) over a long distance. <i>An <b>overland</b> trade route.</i>
<b>pagoda</b>	An ornamental imitation of a Hindu or Buddhist pagoda.

<b><u>prayer</u></b>	The act of communicating with a deity (especially as a petition or in adoration or contrition or thanksgiving. <i>500 people were detained as they attended Friday <b>prayers</b>.</i>
<b>priestess</b>	A woman priest.
<b><u>profane</u></b>	Corrupt morally or by intemperance or sensuality. <i>Children being brought up in an entirely <b>profane</b> environment.</i>
<b>sacrilegious</b>	Involving or committing sacrilege. <i>It seems <b>sacrilegious</b> to say this but it s really not that great a film.</i>
<b><u>secular</u></b>	A secular priest. <b>Secular</b> architecture.
<b><u>seduction</u></b>	The action of seducing someone. <i>The <b>seductions</b> of the mainland.</i>
<b><u>synagogue</u></b>	The building where a Jewish assembly or congregation meets for religious worship and instruction.
<b><u>temporal</u></b>	Characteristic of or devoted to the temporal world as opposed to the spiritual world. <b>Temporal</b> matters of but fleeting moment.
<b><u>temptation</u></b>	The tempting of Jesus by the Devil (see Matt. 4). <i>The <b>temptations</b> of life in London.</i>
<b><u>terrestrial</u></b>	Of or on dry land. <i>The nearest to an angelic being that treads this <b>terrestrial</b> ball.</i>
<b>ungodly</b>	Unreasonably early or inconvenient. <b>Ungodly</b> acts.
<b><u>worldly</u></b>	Characteristic of or devoted to the temporal world as opposed to the spiritual world. <b>Worldly</b> goods and advancement.
