<b>effervescence</b>	Vivacity and enthusiasm. <i>The <b>effervescence</b> of sparkling wine.</i>
<b>elation</b>	An exhilarating psychological state of pride and optimism; an absence of depression. <i>Richard s <b>elation</b> at regaining his health was short lived.</i>
<b>enthusiasm</b>	Something that arouses enthusiasm. <i>The three <b>enthusiasms</b> of his life were politics religion and books.</i>
<b>euphoria</b>	A feeling of great (usually exaggerated) elation. <i>In his <b>euphoria</b> he had become convinced he could defeat them.</i>
<b>exhilaration</b>	A feeling of excitement, happiness, or elation. <i>They felt the <b>exhilaration</b> of victory.</i>
<b>exuberance</b>	The quality of growing profusely; luxuriance. <i>A sense of youthful <b>exuberance</b>.</i>
<b>gladness</b>	Experiencing joy and pleasure.
<b>high spirits</b>	A forward gear with a gear ratio that gives the greatest vehicle velocity for a given engine speed.
<b>high-spiritedness</b>	Exuberant liveliness.
<b>irrepressibility</b>	Irrepressible liveliness and good spirit.
<b>jauntiness</b>	Stylishness as evidenced by a smart appearance.
<b>jollity</b>	Lively and cheerful activity or celebration. <i>He was full of false <b>jollity</b>.</i>
<b>joy</b>	A thing that causes joy. <i>A <b>joy</b> to behold.</i>
<b>joyfulness</b>	The emotion of great happiness.
<b>jubilation</b>	A feeling of extreme joy. <i>Unbelievable scenes of <b>jubilation</b>.</i>
<b>merriment</b>	Activities that are enjoyable or amusing. <i>Her eyes sparkled with <b>merriment</b>.</i>
<b>perkiness</b>	Cheerfulness that bubbles to the surface.
<b>sparkle</b>	A glittering flash of light. <i>She s got a kind of <b>sparkle</b>.</i>
<b>sunniness</b>	The quality of being cheerful and dispelling gloom.
<b>vivacity</b>	Characterized by high spirits and animation. <i>He was struck by her <b>vivacity</b> humour and charm.</i>
<b>zest</b>	The outer coloured part of the peel of citrus fruit, used as flavouring. <i>They campaigned with <b>zest</b> and intelligence.</i>

<b>gutsy</b>	Marked by courage and determination in the face of difficulties or danger; robust and uninhibited-Judith Crist. <i>A smooth Bordeaux that is <b>gutsy</b> enough to accompany steak.</i>
<b>live</b>	Lead a certain kind of life live in a certain style. <i>Only the name <b>lived</b> on.</i>
<b>lively</b>	Full of spirit. <i>A <b>lively</b> tennis ball.</i>
<b>luxuriant</b>	Displaying luxury and furnishing gratification to the senses. <i>Forests of dark <b>luxuriant</b> foliage.</i>

<b>overweening</b>	Showing excessive confidence or pride. <i><b>Overweening</b> ambition.</i>
<b>pert</b>	Characterized by a lightly pert and exuberant quality. <i>A <b>pert</b> slightly plump girl called Rose.</i>
<b>plucky</b>	Showing courage. <i>The <b>plucky</b> youngster has astounded medical staff.</i>
<b>praise</b>	Offering words of homage as an act of worship. <i>They sang a hymn of <b>praise</b> to God.</i>
<u><b>saucy</b></u>	Sexually suggestive in a light-hearted and humorous way. <i>The beret was perched at a <b>saucy</b> angle on her blonde hair.</i>
<u><b>spirited</b></u>	Made lively or spirited. <i>A warm hearted generous <b>spirited</b> man.</i>
<b>sprightly</b>	Full of spirit and vitality. <i>A <b>sprightly</b> dance.</i>
<b>superbly</b>	Extremely well. <i>The tomb is <b>superbly</b> ornamented with fine tracery.</i>
<u><b>vibrant</b></u>	(of colour) bright and striking. <i>The men s <b>vibrant</b> voices.</i>
<u><b>vital</b></u>	Absolutely necessary; essential. <i>A beautiful <b>vital</b> girl.</i>
<u><b>vivacious</b></u>	Vigorous and animated. <i>Her <b>vivacious</b> and elegant mother.</i>
<u><b>vivid</b></u>	Having striking color. <i>A <b>vivid</b> description.</i>
<u><b>wonderfully</b></u>	In a way that inspires delight or admiration; extremely well. <i><b>Wonderfully</b> crafted songs.</i>
