<b><u>effervescent</u></b>	(of a liquid) giving off bubbles. <i>His fertile <b>effervescent</b> mind.</i>
<b>elated</b>	Exultantly proud and joyful; in high spirits. <i>Dozens of <b>elated</b> fans welcomed the champions home.</i>
<b>enthusiastic</b>	Having or showing intense and eager enjoyment, interest, or approval. <i>Was <b>enthusiastic</b> about taking ballet lessons.</i>
<b><u>euphoric</u></b>	Exaggerated feeling of well-being or elation. <i>A <b>euphoric</b> sense of freedom.</i>
<b>exhilarated</b>	Very happy, animated, or elated. <i>The sun and the wind on his back made him feel <b>exhilarated</b> happy to be alive.</i>
<b>exuberant</b>	Produced or growing in extreme abundance. <i>A noisy bunch of <b>exuberant</b> youngsters.</i>
<b>high-spirited</b>	Joyously unrestrained.
<b>in high spirits</b>	Currently fashionable.
<b>irrepressible</b>	Impossible to repress or control. <i>An <b>irrepressible</b> rogue.</i>
<b>jaunty</b>	Having or expressing a lively, cheerful, and self-confident manner. <i>A <b>jaunty</b> red hat.</i>
<b><u>joyful</u></b>	Feeling, expressing, or causing great pleasure and happiness. <i>A <b>joyful</b> heart.</i>
<b>jubilant</b>	Feeling or expressing great happiness and triumph. <i>A large number of <b>jubilant</b> fans ran on to the pitch.</i>
<b>light-hearted</b>	Carefree and happy and lighthearted.
<b><u>merry</u></b>	(of an occasion or season) characterized by festivity and enjoyment. <i>He wished me a <b>merry</b> Christmas.</i>
<b><u>sparkling</u></b>	Shining brightly with flashes of light. <i><b>Sparkling</b> water.</i>
<b><u>sunny</u></b>	(of a place) receiving much sunlight. <i>A <b>sunny</b> day.</i>
<b><u>vivacious</u></b>	Vigorous and animated. <i>A <b>vivacious</b> folk dance.</i>

<b>abundant</b>	Present in great quantity. <i>An <b>abundant</b> supply of water.</i>
<b>active</b>	An active form of a verb. <i>An <b>active</b> bond market.</i>
<b>alive</b>	Capable of erupting. <i>He was kept <b>alive</b> by a feeding tube.</i>
<b>animated</b>	Full of life or excitement; lively. <i>An <b>animated</b> version of the classic fairy tale.</i>
<b><u>animation</u></b>	The condition of living or the state of being alive. <i><b>Animations</b> as backdrops for live action.</i>
<b>boisterous</b>	Violently agitated and turbulent- Ezra Pound. <i><b>Boisterous</b> winds and waves.</i>

<b><u>bouncy</u></b>	Elastic; rebounds readily. <i><b>Bouncy</b> 1960s tunes.</i>
<b>cheerily</b>	In a happy and optimistic way. <i>He chats <b>cheerily</b> about city living.</i>
<b>exuberant</b>	Full of energy, excitement, and cheerfulness. <i><b>Exuberant</b> foliage.</i>
<b><u>feisty</u></b>	Touchy and aggressive. <i>The champion is faced with a <b>feisty</b> challenger.</i>
<b>gutsy</b>	Greedy. <i>The <b>gutsy</b> intensity of her musical involvement.</i>
<b>live</b>	Continue to live through hardship or adversity. <i>Got a shock from a <b>live</b> wire.</i>
<b>lively</b>	Elastic; rebounds readily. <i>A <b>lively</b> period in history.</i>
<b>luxuriant</b>	Marked by complexity and richness of detail. <i>Forests of dark <b>luxuriant</b> foliage.</i>

<b>overweening</b>	Presumptuously arrogant- S.V.Benet- NY Times. <i>Had a witty but <b>overweening</b> manner.</i>
<b>pert</b>	Characterized by a lightly pert and exuberant quality. <i>She had a <b>pert</b> nose and deep blue eyes.</i>
<b>plucky</b>	Having or showing determined courage in the face of difficulties. <i>The <b>plucky</b> youngster has astounded medical staff.</i>
<b>praise</b>	Express approval of. <i>We <b>praise</b> God for past blessings.</i>
<b>saucy</b>	Characterized by a lightly pert and exuberant quality. <i><b>Saucy</b> postcards.</i>
<b>spirited</b>	Made lively or spirited. <i>A <b>spirited</b> dance.</i>
<b>sprightly</b>	Full of spirit and vitality. <i>She was quite <b>sprightly</b> for her age.</i>
<b>superbly</b>	In an impressively splendid manner. <i>The team played <b>superbly</b>.</i>
<b>vibrant</b>	Vigorous and animated. <i>A <b>vibrant</b> cosmopolitan city.</i>
<b>vital</b>	Full of spirit. <i>Secrecy is of <b>vital</b> importance.</i>
<b>vivacious</b>	Attractively lively and animated (typically used of a woman). <i>She was dark haired and <b>vivacious</b>.</i>
<b>vivid</b>	Having striking color. <i><b>Vivid</b> green.</i>
<b>wonderfully</b>	(used as an intensifier) extremely well. <i><b>Wonderfully</b> crafted songs.</i>
<b>zesty</b>	Marked by spirited enjoyment.
