Associations of "Eco friendly" (30 Words)

affable	Friendly, good-natured, or easy to talk to. <i>An affable and agreeable companion.</i>
amiable	Disposed to please- Hal Hinson. <i>An amiable gathering.</i>
amicability	Having a disposition characterized by warmth and friendliness.
amicable	Characterized by friendship and good will. <i>An amicable agreement.</i>
amity	A state of friendship and cordiality. <i>The presence of French troops in Scotland had produced hostility rather than amity.</i>
benign	Not harmful to the environment. <i>An ozone benign refrigerant.</i>
companionable	(of a situation) relaxed and pleasant because shared with friends or friendly people. <i>A companionable pet.</i>
complaisant	Willing to please others or to accept what they do or say without protest. <i>To close one's eyes like a complaisant husband whose wife has taken a lover.</i>
congenial	(of a person) pleasing or liked on account of having qualities or interests that are similar to one's own. <i>He went back to a climate more congenial to his cold stony soul.</i>
convivial	Occupied with or fond of the pleasures of good company. <i>A convivial atmosphere at the reunion.</i>
cordial	Politely warm and friendly. <i>The atmosphere was cordial and relaxed.</i>
cordiality	A cordial disposition.

<u>courteous</u>	Characterized by courtesy and gracious good manners. <i>She was courteous and obliging to all.</i>
extrovert	Relating to denoting or typical of an extrovert. <i>His extrovert personality made him the ideal host.</i>
extroverted	At ease in talking to others. <i>She is extroverted confident and gives rousing lectures.</i>
<u>favor</u>	A feeling of favorable regard. <i>He favors his second daughter.</i>
<u>favorable</u>	(of winds or weather) tending to promote or facilitate. <i>The days were fair and the winds were favorable.</i>
<u>genial</u>	(especially of air or climate) pleasantly mild and warm. <i>A genial host.</i>
<u>gregarious</u>	(of plants) growing in groups that are close together. <i>In the wild trees are usually gregarious plants.</i>
<u>hearty</u>	Providing abundant nourishment. <i>A hearty welcome.</i>
<u>hospitable</u>	Disposed to treat guests and strangers with cordiality and generosity. <i>A hospitable environment.</i>
intimacy	Closeness of observation or knowledge of a subject. <i>The room had a peaceful sense of intimacy about it.</i>
kind	Each of the elements (bread and wine) of the Eucharist. <i>Our neighbor was very kind about the window our son broke.</i>
<u>kindly</u>	Showing or motivated by sympathy and understanding and generosity. <i>A kindly act.</i>
obliging	Willing to do a service or kindness; helpful. <i>It s very obliging of him.</i>
<u>outgoing</u>	A person's regular expenditure. <i>She s always been very outgoing and she s got heaps of friends.</i>
<u>sociable</u>	Willing to talk and engage in activities with other people; friendly. <i>Americans are sociable and gregarious.</i>
sociality	The tendency to associate with others and to form social groups. <i>Mammals as a class are not strong on sociality.</i>
unpretentious	Lacking pretension or affectation. <i>In spite of his fame he was thoroughly unpretentious.</i>
<u>welcoming</u>	Behaving in a polite or friendly way to a guest or new arrival. <i>A welcoming smile.</i>
