convivial Occupied with or fond of the pleasures of good company.

A convivial atmosphere at the reunion.

cordial Politely warm and friendly.

The atmosphere was **cordial** and relaxed.

cordiality A cordial disposition.



courteous Characterized by courtesy and gracious good manners.

She was **courteous** and obliging to all.

extrovert Relating to denoting or typical of an extrovert.

His **extrovert** personality made him the ideal host.

extroverted At ease in talking to others.

She is **extroverted** confident and gives rousing lectures.

favor A feeling of favorable regard.

He **favor**s his second daughter.

(of winds or weather) tending to promote or facilitate.

The days were fair and the winds were **favorable**.

genial (especially of air or climate) pleasantly mild and warm.

A **genial** host.

(of plants) growing in groups that are close together.

In the wild trees are usually **gregarious** plants.

Providing abundant nourishment.

hearty *A hearty* welcome.

hospitable Disposed to treat guests and strangers with cordiality and generosity.

A hospitable environment.

intimacy Closeness of observation or knowledge of a subject.

The room had a peaceful sense of **intimacy** about it.

kind Each of the elements (bread and wine) of the Eucharist.

Our neighbor was very **kind** about the window our son broke.

Showing or motivated by sympathy and understanding and generosity.

A kindly act.

obliging Willing to do a service or kindness; helpful.

It s very **obliging** of him.

outgoing A person's regular expenditure.

She s always been very **outgoing** and she s got heaps of friends.

willing to talk and engage in activities with other people; friendly.

Americans are **sociable** and gregarious.

sociality

The tendency to associate with others and to form social groups.

Mammals as a class are not strong on **sociality**.

unpretentious Lacking pretension or affectation.

In spite of his fame he was thoroughly **unpretentious**.

welcoming

Behaving in a polite or friendly way to a guest or new arrival.

A **welcoming** smile.
