## Associations of "Eco friendly" (30 Words)

<b>affable</b>	Friendly, good-natured, or easy to talk to. <i>An <b>affable</b> and agreeable companion.</i>
<b><a href="#">amiable</a></b>	Disposed to please- Hal Hinson. <i>An <b>amiable</b> gathering.</i>
<b>amicability</b>	Having a disposition characterized by warmth and friendliness.
<b>amicable</b>	Characterized by friendship and good will. <i>An <b>amicable</b> agreement.</i>
<b>amity</b>	A state of friendship and cordiality. <i>The presence of French troops in Scotland had produced hostility rather than <b>amity</b>.</i>
<b><a href="#">benign</a></b>	Not harmful to the environment. <i>An ozone <b>benign</b> refrigerant.</i>
<b>companionable</b>	(of a situation) relaxed and pleasant because shared with friends or friendly people. <i>A <b>companionable</b> pet.</i>
<b>complaisant</b>	Willing to please others or to accept what they do or say without protest. <i>To close one's eyes like a <b>complaisant</b> husband whose wife has taken a lover.</i>
<b><a href="#">congenial</a></b>	(of a person) pleasing or liked on account of having qualities or interests that are similar to one's own. <i>He went back to a climate more <b>congenial</b> to his cold stony soul.</i>
<b>convivial</b>	Occupied with or fond of the pleasures of good company. <i>A <b>convivial</b> atmosphere at the reunion.</i>
<b>cordial</b>	Politely warm and friendly. <i>The atmosphere was <b>cordial</b> and relaxed.</i>
<b>cordiality</b>	A cordial disposition.

<b><u>courteous</u></b>	Characterized by courtesy and gracious good manners. <i>She was <b>courteous</b> and obliging to all.</i>
<b>extrovert</b>	Relating to denoting or typical of an extrovert. <i>His <b>extrovert</b> personality made him the ideal host.</i>
<b>extroverted</b>	At ease in talking to others. <i>She is <b>extroverted</b> confident and gives rousing lectures.</i>
<b><u>favor</u></b>	A feeling of favorable regard. <i>He <b>favors</b> his second daughter.</i>
<b><u>favorable</u></b>	(of winds or weather) tending to promote or facilitate. <i>The days were fair and the winds were <b>favorable</b>.</i>
<b><u>genial</u></b>	(especially of air or climate) pleasantly mild and warm. <i>A <b>genial</b> host.</i>
<b><u>gregarious</u></b>	(of plants) growing in groups that are close together. <i>In the wild trees are usually <b>gregarious</b> plants.</i>
<b><u>hearty</u></b>	Providing abundant nourishment. <i>A <b>hearty</b> welcome.</i>
<b><u>hospitable</u></b>	Disposed to treat guests and strangers with cordiality and generosity. <i>A <b>hospitable</b> environment.</i>
<b>intimacy</b>	Closeness of observation or knowledge of a subject. <i>The room had a peaceful sense of <b>intimacy</b> about it.</i>
<b>kind</b>	Each of the elements (bread and wine) of the Eucharist. <i>Our neighbor was very <b>kind</b> about the window our son broke.</i>
<b><u>kindly</u></b>	Showing or motivated by sympathy and understanding and generosity. <i>A <b>kindly</b> act.</i>
<b>obliging</b>	Willing to do a service or kindness; helpful. <i>It s very <b>obliging</b> of him.</i>
<b><u>outgoing</u></b>	A person's regular expenditure. <i>She s always been very <b>outgoing</b> and she s got heaps of friends.</i>
<b><u>sociable</u></b>	Willing to talk and engage in activities with other people; friendly. <i>Americans are <b>sociable</b> and gregarious.</i>
<b>sociality</b>	The tendency to associate with others and to form social groups. <i>Mammals as a class are not strong on <b>sociality</b>.</i>
<b>unpretentious</b>	Lacking pretension or affectation. <i>In spite of his fame he was thoroughly <b>unpretentious</b>.</i>
<b><u>welcoming</u></b>	Behaving in a polite or friendly way to a guest or new arrival. <i>A <b>welcoming</b> smile.</i>
