<b>andragogy</b>	The method and practice of teaching adult learners; adult education. <i>Much has been written about <b>andragogy</b> in general education circles over the past fifty years.</i>
<b>coaching</b>	Someone in charge of training an athlete or a team.
<b>education</b>	The United States federal department that administers all federal programs dealing with education including federal aid to educational institutions and students created 1979. <i>Colleges of <b>education</b>.</i>
<b>guidance</b>	Something that provides direction or advice as to a decision or course of action. <i>He looked to his father for inspiration and <b>guidance</b>.</i>

<b>instruction</b>	A line of code written as part of a computer program. <i>He was acting on my <b>instructions</b>.</i>
<b>pedagogy</b>	The principles and methods of instruction. <i>The relationship between applied linguistics and language <b>pedagogy</b>.</i>
<b><u>schooling</u></b>	The process of being formally educated at a school. <i><b>Schooling</b> fences.</i>
<b>sophistication</b>	Uplifting enlightenment. <i>He practiced the art of <b>sophistication</b> upon reason.</i>
<b>teaching</b>	A doctrine that is taught. <i>A <b>teaching</b> union.</i>
<b>training</b>	The action of undertaking a course of exercise and diet in preparation for a sporting event. <i>In service <b>training</b> for staff.</i>
<b><u>tuition</u></b>	Teaching pupils individually (usually by a tutor hired privately). <i><b>Tuition</b> and room and board were more than 25 000.</i>
<b>tutelage</b>	Attention and management implying responsibility for safety. <i>He felt privileged to be under the <b>tutelage</b> of an experienced actor.</i>
<b><u>tutoring</u></b>	A person who gives private instruction (as in singing, acting, etc).
