andragogy	The method and practice of teaching adult learners; adult education. <i>Much has been written about andragogy in general education circles over the past fifty years.</i>
coaching	Someone in charge of training an athlete or a team.
education	The United States federal department that administers all federal programs dealing with education including federal aid to educational institutions and students created 1979. <i>Colleges of education.</i>
guidance	Something that provides direction or advice as to a decision or course of action. <i>He looked to his father for inspiration and guidance.</i>

instruction	A line of code written as part of a computer program. <i>He was acting on my instructions.</i>
pedagogy	The principles and methods of instruction. <i>The relationship between applied linguistics and language pedagogy.</i>
<u>schooling</u>	The process of being formally educated at a school. <i>Schooling fences.</i>
sophistication	Uplifting enlightenment. <i>He practiced the art of sophistication upon reason.</i>
teaching	A doctrine that is taught. <i>A teaching union.</i>
training	The action of undertaking a course of exercise and diet in preparation for a sporting event. <i>In service training for staff.</i>
<u>tuition</u>	Teaching pupils individually (usually by a tutor hired privately). <i>Tuition and room and board were more than 25 000.</i>
tutelage	Attention and management implying responsibility for safety. <i>He felt privileged to be under the tutelage of an experienced actor.</i>
<u>tutoring</u>	A person who gives private instruction (as in singing, acting, etc).
