Past Participle	<b>educamated</b>

I <b>educamate</b>	We <b>educamate</b>
You <b>educamate</b>	You <b>educamate</b>
He/She/It <b>educamates</b>	They <b>educamate</b>

### **Educamate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>am educamating</b>	We <b>are educamating</b>
You <b>are educamating</b>	You <b>are educamating</b>
He/She/It <b>is educamating</b>	They <b>are educamating</b>

### **Educamate in Present Perfect Tense**

I <b>have educamated</b>	We <b>have educamated</b>
