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## Associations of "Educating" (30 Words)

<b><u>academy</u></b>	A society or institution of distinguished scholars and artists or scientists that aims to promote and maintain standards in its particular field. <i>A police <b>academy</b>.</i>
<b><u>campus</u></b>	The grounds and buildings of a university or college. <i>For the first year I had a room on <b>campus</b>.</i>
<b>civilize</b>	Raise from a barbaric to a civilized state. <i>The wild child found wandering in the forest was gradually <b>civilized</b>.</i>
<b>college</b>	The body of faculty and students of a college. <i>I m at <b>college</b> studying graphic design.</i>
<b>diploma</b>	An official document or charter.
<b><u>discipline</u></b>	A system of rules of conduct or method of practice. <i>Every month <b>discipline</b> yourself to go through the file.</i>
<b>education</b>	The United States federal department that administers all federal programs dealing with education including federal aid to educational institutions and students created 1979. <i>It was clear that he had a very broad <b>education</b>.</i>
<b><u>educator</u></b>	Someone who educates young people. <i>The perspective of a professional <b>educator</b>.</i>
<b>homeroom</b>	A classroom in which a group of students assembles daily with the same teacher before dispersing to other classes.
<b><u>instruct</u></b>	Give instructions or directions for some task. <i>The bank was <b>instructed</b> that the money from the deposit account was now held by the company.</i>
<b>instruction</b>	The profession of a teacher. <i>He was acting on my <b>instructions</b>.</i>
<b>instructor</b>	A university teacher ranking below assistant professor. <i>A driving <b>instructor</b>.</i>

<b>lecture</b>	Give a lecture to a class or other audience. <i>A <b>lecture</b> hall.</i>
<b>lesson</b>	Instruct or teach (someone). <i>A driving <b>lesson</b>.</i>
<b>matriculate</b>	A person who has matriculated. <i>He was <b>matriculated</b> at Balliol College Oxford.</i>
<b>pedagogics</b>	The principles and methods of instruction.
<b>pedagogy</b>	The profession of a teacher. <i><b>Pedagogy</b> is recognized as an important profession.</i>
<b>polytechnic</b>	An institution of higher education offering courses at degree level or below, especially in vocational subjects.
<b>precept</b>	A rate or tax set by a precept. <i>He believed all the Christian <b>precepts</b>.</i>
<b>pupil</b>	A young person attending school (up through senior high school). <i>They are former <b>pupils</b> of the school.</i>
<b>reading</b>	The action or skill of reading. <i>Suggestions for further <b>reading</b>.</i>
<b><u>schooling</u></b>	The training of an animal (especially the training of a horse for dressage). <i>His parents paid for his <b>schooling</b>.</i>
<b>schoolmaster</b>	Presiding officer of a school.
<b>studying</b>	Reading carefully with intent to remember.
<b>teach</b>	Work as a teacher. <i>She <b>teaches</b> me French.</i>
<b>teaching</b>	The activities of educating or instructing; activities that impart knowledge or skill. <i>I went into <b>teaching</b> because I like working with children.</i>
<b><u>trainee</u></b>	Someone who is being trained. <i><b>Trainee</b> solicitors.</i>
<b><u>tuition</u></b>	A sum of money charged for teaching by a college or university. <i><b>Tuition</b> fees.</i>
<b>undergraduate</b>	Denoting or relating to an undergraduate. <i><b>Undergraduate</b> students.</i>
<b><u>university</u></b>	The body of faculty and students at a university. <i>His daughter is at <b>university</b>.</i>
