According to the Oxford Dictionary of English, "egocentric" as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- Centred in or arising from a person's own individual existence or perspective.
- Thinking only of oneself, without regard for the feelings or desires of others; selfcentred
- Limited to or caring only about yourself and your own needs.

*I joined them for selfish reasons.* 

Having no likelihood of fulfilment; empty. vain

Their flattery made him vain.
