run away to marry Compete in a race.

run away together Have a tendency or disposition to do or be something; be inclined.

run off

Reduce or cause to be reduced from a solid to a liquid state, usually by

heating.

run off together Change from one state to another.

slip away Insert inconspicuously or quickly or quietly.

sneak off Make off with belongings of others.

steal away Move stealthily.
