## Elope as a Verb

### Definitions of "Elope" as a verb

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “elope” as a verb can have the following definitions:

- *Run away secretly with one's beloved.*
- *Run away secretly in order to get married.*

### Synonyms of "Elope" as a verb (7 Words)

**run away to marry** Compete in a race.

**run away together** Have a tendency or disposition to do or be something; be inclined.

**run off** Reduce or cause to be reduced from a solid to a liquid state, usually by heating.

**run off together** Change from one state to another.

**slip away** Insert inconspicuously or quickly or quietly.

**sneak off** Make off with belongings of others.

**steal away** Move stealthily.

### Usage Examples of "Elope" as a verb

- *The young couple eloped and got married in Las Vegas.*

- *Later he eloped with one of the housemaids.*
