Embellishment as a Noun

Definitions of "Embellishment" as a noun

According to the <u>Oxford Dictionary of English</u>, "embellishment" as a noun can have the following definitions:

- Elaboration of an interpretation by the use of decorative (sometimes fictitious) detail.
- The action of adding decorative details.
- A decorative detail or feature added to something to make it more attractive.
- A superfluous ornament.
- A detail, especially one that is untrue, added to a statement or story to make it more interesting.
- The act of adding extraneous decorations to something.





Synonyms of "Embellishment" as a noun (7 Words)

addition	The process of calculating the total of two or more numbers or amounts. <i>The addition of flowers created a pleasing effect.</i>
adornment	A thing which adorns or decorates; an ornament. The necktie is no longer a necessary male adornment .
decoration	Paint or wallpaper applied when decorating a room. <i>He was awarded the highest Australian decoration</i> .
elaboration	The addition of more detail concerning what has already been said. The concept needs more elaboration than a short essay allows.
embroidery	The art or pastime of embroidering cloth. The bazaars stock a wide variety of embroidery .
exaggeration	Extravagant exaggeration. It would be an exaggeration to say I had morning sickness but I did feel queasy.



ornamentation The act of adding extraneous decorations to something. *The rhetorical ornamentation* of text.



Usage Examples of "Embellishment" as a noun

- Stripped of her embellishments, the core of hard fact was disappointingly small.
- The embellishment of church interiors through the use of the visual arts.
- Architectural embellishments.
- The mystery has been heightened by many embellishments in subsequent retellings.
