Synonyms of "Emblematic" as an adjective (17 Words)

allegorical	Constituting or containing allegory. <i>An allegorical painting of Victory leading an army.</i>
characteristic	Typical of a particular person, place, or thing. <i>Stripes characteristic of the zebra.</i>
demonstrative	Serving to demonstrate. <i>Demonstrative evidence.</i>
emblematical	Serving as a visible symbol for something abstract.
evocative	Serving to bring to mind- Wilder Hobson. <i>Powerfully evocative lyrics.</i>

<u>exemplary</u>	Characteristic of its kind or illustrating a general rule. <i>Exemplary</i> sentencing may discourage the violent minority.
figurative	Departing from a literal use of words; metaphorical. <i>The figurative art of the humanistic tradition.</i>
<u>indicative</u>	(usually followed by `of') pointing out or revealing clearly. <i>Actions indicative of fear.</i>
metaphorical	Characteristic of or relating to metaphor; figurative. <i>A metaphorical expression.</i>
parabolic	Having the form of a parabola. <i>A parabolic mirror behind a spotlight projects a parallel beam.</i>
representative	Of a government or political system based on elected or chosen representatives. <i>The show would be more representative of how women really are.</i>
<u>suggestive</u>	Tending to suggest or imply. <i>There were various suggestive pieces of evidence.</i>
<u>symbolic</u>	Serving as a symbol. <i>The spinning wheel was as symbolic of colonial Massachusetts as the codfish.</i>
symbolical	Serving as a visible symbol for something abstract.
symptomatic	Relating to or according to or affecting a symptom or symptoms. <i>Patients with symptomatic coeliac disease.</i>
typic	Being or serving as an illustration of a type.
<u>typical</u>	Having the distinctive qualities of a particular type of person or thing. <i>The typical or normal American.</i>

- *The free discussion that is emblematic of democracy.*
- *This case is emblematic of a larger problem.*
- *A crown is emblematic of royalty.*
