metaphorical Characteristic of or relating to metaphor; figurative.

A metaphorical expression.

parabolic Having the form of a parabola.

A **parabolic** mirror behind a spotlight projects a parallel beam.

Of a government or political system based on elected or chosen

representative representatives.

The show would be more **representative** of how women really are.

Tending to suggest or imply.

<u>suggestive</u>

Serving as a symbol.
