bodied	Having a body or trunk, typically of a specified kind. <i>Big bodied</i> .
corporal	Affecting or characteristic of the body as opposed to the mind or spirit. What seemed corporal melted as breath into the wind.
corporate	Possessing or existing in bodily form- Shakespeare. Local authorities like other corporate bodies may reduce capital spending.
incarnate	(especially of a deity or spirit) embodied in human form. A monarch regarded as a god incarnate .

adipose	(especially of body tissue) used for the storage of fat.
auipose	Adipose tissue constitutes the fat of meat.



<u>archetype</u>	A very typical example of a certain person or thing. An instrument which was the archetype of the early flute.
<u>cognition</u>	A perception sensation idea or intuition resulting from the process of cognition.
<u>conceptual</u>	Being or characterized by concepts or their formation. Philosophy deals with conceptual difficulties.
<u>configuration</u>	An arrangement of parts or elements in a particular form, figure, or combination. The PC comes with a removable hard disk drive as part of the standard configuration .
contents	A list of divisions (chapters or articles) and the pages on which they start. <i>He emptied the contents of his pockets.</i>
<u>corporeal</u>	Having a body. That which is created is of necessity corporeal and visible and tangible.
form	An ability to perform well. To form a judgement he seeks further in form ation.
formation	A group of people or things in a particular arrangement or pattern. The formation of the Great Rift Valley.
<u>frame</u>	The framework for a pair of eyeglasses. <i>He claims he was framed</i> .
framework	An essential supporting structure of a building, vehicle, or object. Providing a factual framework for future research.
idea	A mental impression. It s a good idea to do some research before you go.
lattice	An interlaced structure or pattern resembling a lattice. A lattice fence.
<u>metaphor</u>	A figure of speech in which a word or phrase is applied to an object or action to which it is not literally applicable. <i>Her poetry depends on suggestion and metaphor.</i>
model	Plan or create according to a model or models. The company revealed their latest model at the Motor Show.
morphological	Relating to the form or structure of things. <i>The language s phonological morphological and syntactic structure.</i>
<u>morphology</u>	A particular form, shape, or structure. Grammar is organized along two main dimensions morphology and syntax.



oblong	Having the shape of an oblong. Oblong tables.
poser	A person who poses for a photographer or painter or sculptor.
<u>shape</u>	Shape or influence give direction to. <i>He could barely make out their shapes.</i>
simulate	Create a representation or model of. Future population changes were simulate d by computer.
simulation	Imitation of a situation or process. A simulation should imitate the internal processes and not merely the results of the thing being simulated.
<u>skeleton</u>	A sport in which a competitor races down a frozen track on a skeleton sled. The skeleton s runners make a terrifying rumbling sound as they slide down the ice.
spheroid	A solid generated by a half revolution of an ellipse about its major axis prolate spheroid or minor axis oblate spheroid. It looked like a sphere but on closer examination I saw it was really a spheroid .
structure	Give a structure to. We shall use three headings to give some structure to the discussion.
symbolism	A system of symbols and symbolic representations. The old fashioned symbolism of flowers.
template	Something that serves as a model for others to copy. Secondary structure in the template strand is eliminated.
topic	The subject matter of a conversation or discussion. Sleep deprivation became a frequent topic of conversation.
triangle	A percussion instrument consisting of a metal bar bent in the shape of an open triangle. A small triangle of grass.
visualization	The representation of an object, situation, or set of information as a chart or other image. <i>A powerful visualization of a future dystopia.</i>
