### Synonyms of "Embodied" as an adjective (4 Words)

<b>bodied</b>	Having a body or trunk, typically of a specified kind. <i>Big <b>bodied</b>.</i>
<b>corporal</b>	Affecting or characteristic of the body as opposed to the mind or spirit. <i>What seemed <b>corporal</b> melted as breath into the wind.</i>
<b>corporate</b>	Possessing or existing in bodily form- Shakespeare. <i>Local authorities like other <b>corporate</b> bodies may reduce capital spending.</i>
<b>incarnate</b>	(especially of a deity or spirit) embodied in human form. <i>A monarch regarded as a god <b>incarnate</b>.</i>

<b>adipose</b>	(especially of body tissue) used for the storage of fat. <i><b>Adipose</b> tissue constitutes the fat of meat.</i>

<a href="#"><u>archetype</u></a>	A very typical example of a certain person or thing. <i>An instrument which was the <b>archetype</b> of the early flute.</i>
<a href="#"><u>cognition</u></a>	A perception sensation idea or intuition resulting from the process of cognition.
<a href="#"><u>conceptual</u></a>	Being or characterized by concepts or their formation. <i>Philosophy deals with <b>conceptual</b> difficulties.</i>
<a href="#"><u>configuration</u></a>	An arrangement of parts or elements in a particular form, figure, or combination. <i>The PC comes with a removable hard disk drive as part of the standard <b>configuration</b>.</i>
<b>contents</b>	A list of divisions (chapters or articles) and the pages on which they start. <i>He emptied the <b>contents</b> of his pockets.</i>
<a href="#"><u>corporeal</u></a>	Having a body. <i>That which is created is of necessity <b>corporeal</b> and visible and tangible.</i>
<b>form</b>	An ability to perform well. <i>To <b>form</b> a judgement he seeks further <b>information</b>.</i>
<b>formation</b>	A group of people or things in a particular arrangement or pattern. <i>The <b>formation</b> of the Great Rift Valley.</i>
<a href="#"><u>frame</u></a>	The framework for a pair of eyeglasses. <i>He claims he was <b>framed</b>.</i>
<b>framework</b>	An essential supporting structure of a building, vehicle, or object. <i>Providing a factual <b>framework</b> for future research.</i>
<b>idea</b>	A mental impression. <i>It s a good <b>idea</b> to do some research before you go.</i>
<b>lattice</b>	An interlaced structure or pattern resembling a lattice. <i>A <b>lattice</b> fence.</i>
<a href="#"><u>metaphor</u></a>	A figure of speech in which a word or phrase is applied to an object or action to which it is not literally applicable. <i>Her poetry depends on suggestion and <b>metaphor</b>.</i>
<b>model</b>	Plan or create according to a model or models. <i>The company revealed their latest <b>model</b> at the Motor Show.</i>
<b>morphological</b>	Relating to the form or structure of things. <i>The language s phonological <b>morphological</b> and syntactic structure.</i>
<a href="#"><u>morphology</u></a>	A particular form, shape, or structure. <i>Grammar is organized along two main dimensions <b>morphology</b> and syntax.</i>

<b>oblong</b>	Having the shape of an oblong. <i><b>Oblong</b> tables.</i>
<b>poser</b>	A person who poses for a photographer or painter or sculptor.
<b><u>shape</u></b>	Shape or influence give direction to. <i>He could barely make out their <b>shapes</b>.</i>
<b>simulate</b>	Create a representation or model of. <i>Future population changes were <b>simulated</b> by computer.</i>
<b>simulation</b>	Imitation of a situation or process. <i>A <b>simulation</b> should imitate the internal processes and not merely the results of the thing being simulated.</i>
<b><u>skeleton</u></b>	A sport in which a competitor races down a frozen track on a skeleton sled. <i>The <b>skeleton</b> s runners make a terrifying rumbling sound as they slide down the ice.</i>
<b>spheroid</b>	A solid generated by a half revolution of an ellipse about its major axis prolate spheroid or minor axis oblate spheroid. <i>It looked like a sphere but on closer examination I saw it was really a <b>spheroid</b>.</i>
<b>structure</b>	Give a structure to. <i>We shall use three headings to give some <b>structure</b> to the discussion.</i>
<b>symbolism</b>	A system of symbols and symbolic representations. <i>The old fashioned <b>symbolism</b> of flowers.</i>
<b>template</b>	Something that serves as a model for others to copy. <i>Secondary structure in the <b>template</b> strand is eliminated.</i>
<b>topic</b>	The subject matter of a conversation or discussion. <i>Sleep deprivation became a frequent <b>topic</b> of conversation.</i>
<b>triangle</b>	A percussion instrument consisting of a metal bar bent in the shape of an open triangle. <i>A small <b>triangle</b> of grass.</i>
<b>visualization</b>	The representation of an object, situation, or set of information as a chart or other image. <i>A powerful <b>visualization</b> of a future dystopia.</i>
