Infinitive	to emotionalise
Present Tense	emotionalise / emotionalises
Past Tense	emotionalised
Present Participle	emotionalising
Past Participle	emotionalised

# **Conjugate Emotionalise**

### **Emotionalise in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I emotionalise	We <b>emotionalise</b>
You <b>emotionalise</b>	You <b>emotionalise</b>
He/She/It emotionalises	They <b>emotionalise</b>

### **Emotionalise in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am emotionalising	We are emotionalising
You are emotionalising	You <b>are emotionalising</b>
He/She/It is emotionalising	They are emotionalising

#### **Emotionalise in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have emotionalised	We have emotionalised
You have emotionalised	You have emotionalised
He/She/It has emotionalised	They have emotionalised

### **Emotionalise in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been emotionalising	We have been emotionalising
You <b>have been emotionalising</b>	You have been emotionalising
He/She/It has been emotionalising	They have been emotionalising

### **Emotionalise in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I emotionalised	We <b>emotionalised</b>
You <b>emotionalised</b>	You <b>emotionalised</b>
He/She/It emotionalised	They <b>emotionalised</b>

### **Emotionalise in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was emotionalising	We were emotionalising
You were emotionalising	You were emotionalising
He/She/It was emotionalising	They were emotionalising

#### **Emotionalise in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had emotionalised	We had emotionalised
You <b>had emotionalised</b>	You had emotionalised
He/She/It had emotionalised	They had emotionalised

#### **Emotionalise in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been emotionalising	We had been emotionalising
You <b>had been emotionalising</b>	You <b>had been emotionalising</b>
He/She/It had been emotionalising	They had been emotionalising

### **Emotionalise in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will emotionalise	We <b>will emotionalise</b>
You <b>will emotionalise</b>	You <b>will emotionalise</b>
He/She/It will emotionalise	They <b>will emotionalise</b>

### **Emotionalise in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be emotionalising	We <b>will be emotionalising</b>
You <b>will be emotionalising</b>	You will be emotionalising
He/She/It will be emotionalising	They will be emotionalising

### **Emotionalise in Future Perfect Tense**



Singular	Plural
I will have emotionalised	We will have emotionalised
You <b>will have emotionalised</b>	You will have emotionalised
He/She/It will have emotionalised	They will have emotionalised

## **Emotionalise in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been emotionalising	We will have been emotionalising
You <b>will have been emotionalising</b>	You <b>will have been emotionalising</b>
He/She/It will have been emotionalising	They will have been emotionalising
