I **empolder**                      We **empolder**

He/She/It **empolders**    They **empolder**

**Empolder in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

I **am empoldering**            We **are empoldering**  
You **are empoldering**        You **are empoldering**  
He/She/It **is empoldering**    They **are empoldering**

**Empolder in Present Perfect Tense**

I **have empoldered**            We **have empoldered**  
You **have empoldered**        You **have empoldered**  
He/She/It **has empoldered**    They **have empoldered**

**We will have empoldered**
